WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, **Prabhath D.Ed College, Kasara No. 269 and 270, Parnapally Village and Post Office, Taluka and City, Kurnool District-518501, Andhra Pradesh** run by **Prabhath Educational Society, Plot No. 17/130A, Park Road, Nandyal Village and Post Office, Nandyal Taluka and City, Kurnool District-518501, Andhra Pradesh** vide SRC (NCTE) order No F.No. SRCAPP993/D.EI.Ed/a.p/2012/46252 dated 18.09.2012 for conducting **D.EI.Ed** Course of two-year duration with an annual intake of **50 students** from the academic session 2012-2013.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, a letter No. RC.No. 359/A/SCERT/2019 dated 29.6.2020 is received from the Commissioner, School Education (FAC), School Education Department, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh on 17.07.2020 recommending therein for derecognition order in respect of 188 Pvt. D.EI.Ed. Colleges in A.P. since the said managements of Pvt. D.EI.Ed. Colleges have made admission into the D.EI.Ed. Course during academic year 2018-19 on their own in violation of Government orders.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered by SRC in its 386th meeting held on 23rd – 24th July, 2020 and decided to issue a Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 05.08.2020. The institution has submitted the reply of the Show Cause notice on 14.09.2020.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 401st Meeting held on 11th & 12th August, 2021 considered the matter and decided as under:-

“The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

1. The Committee in its 386th meeting after perusal of the letter No. RC.No. 359/A/SCERT/2019 dated 29.6.2020 received from the Commissioner, School Education (FAC), School Education Department, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh recommending therein for derecognition order in respect of 188 Pvt.D.EI.Ed. colleges in A.P. since the said managements of Pvt.D.EI.Ed. colleges have made admissions into the D.EI.Ed. course during academic year 2018-19 on their own in violation of Government orders. Accordingly, the SRC decided to issue a Show

Cause Notice to all such institutions asking therein to explain about the observations made by the School Education Department, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh vide letter No. R.C.No. 359/A/SCERT/2019 dated 29.6.2020.

2. In view of the above decision a Show Cause Notice dated 05.08.2020 was issued to the institution and the institution vide dated 25.08.2020 has submitted its representation. The institution failed to submit satisfactory explanation on the observation made by the School Education Department, Govt. of AP is not satisfactory as the institution made admission into the D.El.Ed. course during academic year 2018-19 on their own in violation of Govt. orders.
3. Further on perusal of the reply on 25.08.2020 submitted by the institution, the institution also failed to submit the following documents/information:-
 - a) The institution has submitted photocopy of land documents instead of certified copy/ notarized copy.
 - b) The institution has submitted Non-Encumbrance Certificate in which searching period, in the name of NEC are not mentioned.
 - c) The institution has submitted photocopy of building plan and site plan but not readable.
 - d) The institution has submitted attested copy of Building Completion Certificate but not in prescribed format as NCTE Regulation 2014.
 - e) The institution has submitted photocopy of faculty list Signed by the Camp Officer & District Educational Officer vide letter dated 19.03.2015, latest copy of faculty not submitted.
 - f) The institution has submitted attested photocopy FDRs but not readable, the institution required to submit a "Form A" issued by the respective Bank Manager towards creation of FDR of Rs.7 lakh and 5 lakh, totalling Rs.12 lakh towards Endowment Fund & Reserve Fund into joint account for a duration of 5 years along with a copy of the FDRs.
 - g) The institution has not satisfactorily replied with reference to irregularities made by the institution as pointed out by the School Education Department Government of Andhra Pradesh vide letter No. 359/A/SCERT/2019 dated 29.06.2020.

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Prabhath D.Ed College, Kasara No. 269 and 270, Parnapally Village and Post Office, Taluka and City, Kurnool District-518501, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting **D.El.Ed. Programme** with effect from the academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."

5. **NOW, THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of **Prabhath D.Ed College, Kasara No. 269 and 270, Parnapally Village and Post Office, Taluka and City, Kurnool District-518501, Andhra Pradesh** for **D.El.Ed. Programme** with effect from the next academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
