WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, **Karavali College of Education, N.H. 17. Near Kottara Chowki, Mangalore, Karnataka-575013** run by **G. R. Education Trust, Mangalore, Karnataka** vide SRC vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2004-2005 /5696 dt. 25.11.2004 for Secondary (**B.Ed.**) course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2004-2005.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dated 17.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 16.05.2015 for conducting **B.Ed. programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **100 students for two basic units** from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 381st meeting held on 31st October – 01st November 2019 and 387th meeting held on 24th & 25th August 2020 decided that a SCN be issued in all such matters which have not complied with the conditions mentioned in the RPRO. Accordingly, as per decision a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on dt. 31.08.2020. The institution has submitted a written representation dt. 19.10.2020.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 393rd Meeting held on 05th & 06th January 2021, the matter was considered before the Committee and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 19.01.2021. The institution has not submitted any reply in response to the Final Show Cause Notice.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 403rd Meeting held on 18th & 19th October, 2021 considered the FSCN reply matter and decided as under: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice on 19.01.2021. The institution failed to submit reply to the Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN).

*Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Karavali College of Education, N.H. 17. Near Kottara Chowki, Mangalore, Karnataka-575013** for conducting **B.Ed. programme** with effect from the academic session i.e., **2021-2022** onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."*

6. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Karavali College of Education, N.H. 17. Near Kottara Chowki, Mangalore, Karnataka-575013** run by **G. R. Education Trust, Mangalore, Karnataka** for conducting **B.Ed. programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **100 students (2 basic units)** with effect from the academic session i.e., 2021-2022 onwards.

7. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

8. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
