WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

AND WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **Emmanuel College of B.Ed. Training Vazhichal Kudappanamoodu P.O. Thiruvananthapuram - 695510 Kerala** vide SRC (NCTE) order No F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2004-2005/904 dated 25.02.2005 for conducting **B.Ed. course** of one-year duration with an annual intake of **100 students** from the academic session **2007-2008**.

2. AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted an affidavit dated **20.01.2015** for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

3. AND WHEREAS, a Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on **15.05.2015** for conducting **B.Ed. course** of two years duration with an annual intake of **100 students (Two basic units)** from the academic session 2015-2016.

4. AND WHEREAS, the institution submitted written representation on 21.06.2016 and 27.06.2016 and requesting for reduction of strength from **100 students (Two basic units) to 50 students (1 unit)** in its B.Ed. course.

5. AND WHEREAS, the request was placed before SRC in its 343th meeting held on 1st to 2nd August, 2017 and the Committee decided that "reduction of intake from 2 units to 1 unit in the B.Ed. course is permitted".

6. AND WHEREAS, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance.

7. AND WHEREAS, accordingly, **First Show Cause Notice issued on 07.05.2019** to reply within 30 days. The institution submitted its reply vide dated 31.05.2019 and reply received on 03.06.2019

8. AND WHEREAS, SRC in its 381st meeting held on 31st Oct - 01st Nov 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue a Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of NCTE Act, 1993.

9. AND WHEREAS, accordingly, Final Show Cause Notice issued to the institution on **15.09.2020**. The institution submitted its reply vide letter dated **29.09.2020** received on **07.10.2020**.

10. AND WHEREAS, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 390th meeting held on October 28th -29th, 2020 and the Committee decided as follows:-

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN) The institution has submitted its reply on 07.10.2020. The Committee observed the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies.

1. The institution submitted only notarized copy of English translation of the land documents and failed in submission of certified copy of Land Document issued by the Revenue Department.
2. The institution submitted a translated copy of CLU. The true copy of CLU in Regional language but the same is not in proper format of Kerala Govt. Further, there is no reference about due fee deposited/application etc. are mentioned in submitted CLU.
3. The building Plan submitted by the institution is having the size of multi-purpose hall as only 130 sqm which is less than 2000 sq.ft. as required under NCTE Regulations, 2014.
4. The institution did not submit any information regarding separate toilet facility for male and female students, staff and for differently abled persons. The total area/built-up area has also not been mentioned in the Building Plan.
5. The notarized English version copy of NEC has not been submitted by the institution.
6. The institution has not submitted BCC in prescribed format and the same is not approved by the Competent Authority.
7. *The Institution has submitted Notarized copy of Staff list approved by the University of Kerala wherein only Five Assistant Professors are available against the requirement of 1+9 as per NCTE Norms.*
8. *The following deficiencies in faculty List are as follows: - (For One basic unit)*
 - a) *Faculty list does not have a principal.*
 - b) *Faculty in r/o Fine Arts, Performing Arts&Physical Education are not appointed.*
 - c) *The details of administrative and Professional staff are not provided.*
9. The institution has submitted the Form "A" towards creating Endowment and Reserve fund of Rs -9+3=12 lakh in joint operation of institution and

RD, SRC, NCTE. But copies of FDRs are still in the name of institution only.

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Emmanuel College of B.Ed. Training Vazhichal Kudappanamoodu P.O. Thiruvananthapuram-695121, Kerala** for conducting **B.Ed** course w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

11. NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Emmanuel College of B.Ed. Training Vazhichal Kudappanamoodu P.O. Thiruvananthapuram - 695510 Kerala** for conducting **B.Ed. course** of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students w.e.f. the next academic session.

12. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

13. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
