ORDER

120787-120794

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, **Adi Sankara Training College, Sankar Nagar, Mattoor, Kalady Post, Ernakulam District – 683574, Kerala** vide SRC (NCTE) order No. F.KL/SEC/N/124/SRO/NCTE/2004-2005/755 dated 23.02.2005 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2004-2005.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution by consented to come under new Regulations vide a notarized affidavit dated 21.01.2015.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, a Revised Provisional Recognition Order (RPRO) was issued to the institution on 20.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (Two units) from the academic session 2015-2016.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, The above request of the institution was placed before the SRC in its 349<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup> December The Committee considered the matter and decided as under: -

1. This is a request for reduction from B.Ed (2 units) to B.Ed (1 Unit).

2. We have prescribed certain formalities to be completed before such a request can be entertained.

See that such cases are always put up when all formalities have been completed.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, Accordingly, a notice dt 27.12.2017 was issued to the institution to submit the written representation as directed in the notice. The institution has submitted its reply on 06.04.2018. However, No formal order for reduction of intake from B.Ed (2 Units) to B.Ed (1 unit) was issued.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, Now, the institution vide letter dt. 19.03.2020 requested for 2 units in B.Ed. The institution vide letter dt 19.03.2020.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 388<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> September 2020 and the committee decided that first Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance.

8. **AND WHEREAS**, Accordingly, First Show Cause Notice issued on 24.09.2020. The institution vide letter dated 24.10.2020 submitted its reply to the First Show Cause Notice.

9. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 390<sup>th</sup> meeting held on October 28<sup>th</sup> -29<sup>th</sup>, 2020 and the Committee decided as follows:-

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

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On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, the Committee decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution **Adi Sankara Training College, Sankar Nagar, Mattoor, Kalady Post, Ernakulam District 683574, Kerala** for B.Ed programme for 2 basic unit of 50 students each unit.

10. NOW THEREFORE, this order is issued permitting the institution **Adi Sankara Training College, Sankar Nagar, Mattoor village Survey no 81/4, Kalady Panchayat, Ward No. 11 Kalady Post, Ernakulam District 683574, Kerala** for B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:

11. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc as applicable.

12. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

13. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme (s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely: -

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
- b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c. Name of faculty members who left of joined during the last, quarter:
- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
- e. Fee charged from students;
- f. Available infrastructural facilities;
- g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

14. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.

15. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.

16. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.  
Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.
