WITHDRAWAL ORDER

AND WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, **Kannur Salafi B.Ed. College, Village Mukku, P.O. Chekkikulam Kannur- 670592, Kerala** vide SRC (NCTE) order No.F.KL/SRO/NCTE/2007-2008/15673 dated **05.12.2007** for conducting **B.Ed. course** of one-year duration with an annual intake of **100 students** from the academic session **2007-2008**.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted an affidavit dated **19.01.2015** for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, a Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on **13.05.2015** for conducting **B.Ed. course** of two years duration with an annual intake of **100 students (two basic units)** from the academic session **2015-2016**.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the request of the institution was placed before SRC in its 343rd meeting held on August 1-2, 2017 and the committee considered the matter and decided to issue order for the reduction of strength and resubmit the case for RPRO processing. Accordingly, order for reduction of strength issued to the institution on **12.09.2017**.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the request of the institution was placed before SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28th January, 2019 and the committee considered the matter and decided to Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institution which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly Show Cause Notice issued on **04.10.2019**.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, The matter was further considered by the SRC in its 383rd meeting held on 7th -9th January 2020 and the Committee decided as follows: -

The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Institution was issued a Show Cause Notice (SCN) on 17.07.2019. The institution has not submitted any reply / written representation against the Show Cause Notice issued. Hence, the Committee decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice for **B.Ed. courses** to the institution to submit the following documents :-

1. The institution is required to submit certified copy of registrar land.
2. The institution is required to submit original blue-print of Building Plan duly approved by the competent authority.

3. NEC submitted in regional language. The institution is required to submit translated true copy of NEC.
4. Approved Staff List has submitted, but not sufficient as per NCTE Regulations.

Therefore, the Committee decided to issue **Final Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of NCTE Act, 1993** before withdrawal of the recognition on the grounds mentioned above to the institution. The institution is required to submit the documents within 21 days from the date of issue of Final Show Cause Notice.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, as per decision taken in the meeting 383rd, a Final Show Cause was issued to the institution on **10.01.2020**. In response, the institution submitted its reply on **17.02.2020**.

8. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 389th meeting held on October 12th & 14th, 2020 and the Committee decided as follows: -

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN) dated 21.01.2020. The institution has submitted its reply on 17.02.2020. The Committee considered the reply and found the following deficiencies: -

1. The institution has submitted Notarized copy of Land documents but the same are not approved by the competent authority.
2. The institution has submitted a computerized copy of Non - Encumbrance Certificate, which is digitally signed by Raghesh Chathoth, Registering Officer, Registration Department. The institution has not submitted notarized translated version of the same.
3. The institution has submitted an Original staff list approved by the Kannur University consisting of one Principal & Eight Assistant Professor (One basic unit) vide dated Nil, Some deficiencies observed in staff list are:-
 - a. Percentage of marks in PG degree 2 Lecturers is less than 55%. The details of the staff are as follows: -
 - I. Mrs. Aiswarya Lakshmi M" (Malayalam)
 - II. Mrs. Soorya K" (English)
 - b. One Assistant Professor does not possess NET qualification as per NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) (Amendment) Regulation, 2017 date 29.05.2017 notified on 09.06.2017.
 - c. Faculty in r/o Fine Arts & performing Arts not appointment.

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Kannur Salafi B.Ed. College, Village Mukku P.O., Chekkikulam Kannur-670592, Kerala** for conducting B.Ed course w.e.f. the 2020-21 academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

9. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Kannur Salafi B.Ed. College, Village Mukku, P.O. Chekkikulam Kannur- 670592, Kerala** for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students w.e.f. the next academic session.

10. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

11. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filling appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
