ORDER

WHEREAS, the institution **M.E.C.F. College of Teacher Education, Peringathur Post, Thalassery (Via) Kannur District-670675, Kerala** was granted recognition vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F. SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2008-2009/4430 dt. 30.08.2005 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution by a notarized affidavit dt. 28.01.2015 consented to come under new Regulations.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the Southern Regional Committee (NCTE) issued the Revised Provisional Recognition order dt. 13.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students) from the academic session 2015-2016 subject to fulfilment of conditions mentioned therein. A Corrigendum issued dated 12.08.2015 affidavit consented to come under New Regulations and sought for one basic unit in B.Ed.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, Show Cause Notice issued on 13.03.2019. In response, the institution submitted its written representation on 16.04.2019. The SRC in its 382nd meeting held on 26th & 27th November 2019 and the committee decided that Final Show Cause Notice be issued. Accordingly, Final Show Cause Notice issued on 10.12.2019. The institution vide dated no 01.01.2020 submitted reply to Final Show Cause Notice.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 387th meeting held on 24th & 25th August 2020 and the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition. Accordingly, withdrawal order was issued on 07.09.2020.

1. The present Principal of the institution namely Sri Rajagopalan is a retired from Government Institution and joined afresh in this instant college but is not possessing Ph.D. and also having only 52.35% marks in M.A. (Eng.) which do not fulfil the requirement stipulated under Appendix 4 of NCTE Regulations, 2014. Accordingly, the institution is required to appointment one qualified principal as per NCTE Regulations, 2014 duly approved by the Registrar, of concerned affiliating university.

8. AND WHEREAS, Accordingly, letter was issued on 09.11.2020. The institution submitted its reply on 22.12.2020.

9. NOW THEREFORE, this order is issued permitting the institution in continuation of conducting **M.E.C.F. College of Teacher Education, Peringathur Post, Thalassery (Via) Kannur District-670675, (Survey No. 12/4, Ward No. 18) Kerala** run by **Muslim Educational and Cultural Forum (MECF) Peringathur P.O. Kannur, Kerala-670675** for B.Ed. course of two years duration with an intake of 50 students (one basic units of 50 student) subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

10. Further, the institution is required to fulfil all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc as applicable.

11. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

12. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter - alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely: -

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
- b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter:
- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
- e. Fee charged from students;
- f. Available infrastructural facilities;
- g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

13. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.

14. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.

15. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued thereunder, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provision of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.
