WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

AND WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, **H.H. Marthoma Mathew II Training College, Adoor, Pathanamthitta District-691529, Kerala** run by **The Malankara Orthodox Syrian Church** vide SRC (NCTE) order No. **F.KL/SEC/N/179/SRO/NCTE/2004-2005/903** dated **25.02.2005** for conducting **B.Ed. course** of one-year duration with an annual intake of **100** students from the academic session **2004-2005**.

2. AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is not submitted an affidavit.

3. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 294th meeting held on 14th – 16th November 2015 considered the matter of the institution for ascertaining the compliance by the institution and decided to issue a show cause notice to the institution for withdrawal of recognition. Accordingly, show cause notice (SCN) dt. 20.05.2016 was issued to the institution.

4. AND WHEREAS, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 386th meeting held on 23rd & 24th July 2020 and the Committee decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, Final Show Cause Notice was issued on 05.08.2020. The institution has submitted its reply against Final Show cause on **09.11.2020**.

5. AND WHEREAS, the institution has filed W.P. (C) 22050 of 2020(E) In the High Court of Kerala at Ernakulam.

6. AND WHEREAS, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 392nd meeting held on 15th -16th December 2020 and the Committee decided as follows: -

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The Committee observed the reply submitted by the institution and found following deficiencies: -

1. The institution was granted recognition vide order dt 25.02.2005 for conducting B.Ed course with an annual intake of 100 students and on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014. The institution did not submit Affidavit for adherence of provisions of NCTE Regulations, 2014. Failure in non-submission of Affidavit resulted in Non-issuance of Revised Provisional Recognition Order for conducting B.Ed course of 2 years duration.

Accordingly, a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 20.05.2016. Further, a Final show cause notice dt 05.08.2020 was issued to the institution.

2. The institution submitted the Land Use Certificate dt 27.08.2020 signed by the Tahsildar, Adoor, which shows functioning of the School and B.Ed college in the same building. And, the total built up area as per Building Plan and BCC submitted by the institution is only 2803.60 sq. mtr. The total area specified for the B.Ed course is only 1526.60 sq.mtr which is not sufficient for both institutions.

3. The institution submitted the proforma of the faculty for 8 faculty but the faculty is not approved by the Affiliating body.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to H.H. Marthoma Mathew II Training College, Adoor, Pathanamthitta District-691529, Kerala for conducting B.Ed course w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

7. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **H.H. Marthoma Mathew II Training College, Adoor, Pathanamthitta District-691529, Kerala** for conducting **B.Ed. course** of two years duration with an annual intake of **100 students** w.e.f. the next academic session.

8. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

9. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
