WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

AND WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, **Dr. Palpu Memorial S.N.D.P Yogam College of Education, Kodungallur, Pin-680664, Thrissur District, Kerala run by Dr. Palpu Memorial S.N.D.P Yogam College of Education, Kodungallur-680664, Thrissur, Kerala** vide SRC (NCTE) order No. F.KL/M.Ed./SRO/NCTE/2006-2007/7240 dated **18.08.2006** for conducting **M.Ed. course** of one-year duration with an annual intake of **25** students from the academic session **2006-2007**.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, consequent upon the notification of the National Council for Teacher Education (Amendment) Regulation, 2010 on dated 26.07.2010, the intake of existing 25 students in M.Ed. course was increased from **25 to 35** vide SRC, NCTE order F. SRO/NCTE/2010-2011/20698 dated **25.08.2010**.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution by consented to come under new Regulations vide a notarized affidavit dated **19.01.2015**.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the Southern Regional Committee (NCTE) issued the Revised Provisional Recognition order dt.31.05.2015 for conducting M.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (one basic units) from the academic session 2015-2016 subject to fulfilment of conditions mentioned therein.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, Show Cause Notice issued on 22.07.2019, The institution submitted its reply on 09.10.2019.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, SRC in its 388th meeting held on 14th -15th September 2020 decided sending a last reminder (Letter) Accordingly, Letter was issued on 21.09.2020. The institution submitted its reply on 23.10.2020.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 392nd meeting held on 15th -16th December 2020 and the Committee decided as follows: -

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

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On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, the Committee decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution Dr. Palpu Memorial S.N.D.P Yogam college of Education, Kodungallur 680664, Kerala for B.Ed programme for 1 basic unit of 50 students.

In view of the request made by the management, the Committee also decided to withdraw the recognition granted for M.Ed course w.e.f. this academic session.

8. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Dr. Palpu Memorial S.N.D.P Yogam College of Education, Kodungallur, Pin-680664, Thrissur District, Kerala** or conducting **M.Ed. course** of two years duration with an annual intake of **50** students w.e.f. this academic session.

9. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

10. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
