CONTINUATION ORDER

WHEREAS, the institution Diana College of Education, No. 68, Chokkanahalli Village, Hege Nagar Main Road, Jakkur Post, Yelahanka Hobli, Bangalore-560064, Karnataka was granted recognition vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2004-2005/9035 dated 02.12.2004 for conducting Secondary (B.Ed.) course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2004-2005.

AND WHEREAS, after the promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014 and as per affidavits submitted by the institution on dt. 02.02.2015, the provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 16.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 24.04.2019. The institution has submitted vide dated 10.11.2019 its reply to the show cause notice.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 282nd meeting held on 26th – 27th November 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue an order to the institution i.e., Diana College of Education, Sy. No. 68/3, New Municipal Khata No. 12/68 of Chokkanahalli Village, Yelahanka Hobli, Bengaluru North Taluk, Bengaluru District, Karnataka run by Diana Education Trust, No. 27, 2nd Cross, Adharsha Nagar, R.T. Nagar Post, Bangalore, Karnataka – 560032 for B.Ed. course of two years duration with an intake of 50 students (one unit). Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC an order vide no. F.SRC/NCTE/APS01695/B.Ed./KA/2019/112479-2486, dated 05.12.2019 was issued to the institution.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 395th meeting held on 25th – 26th February 2021 considered the matter and decided to issue first Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, First Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 08.03.2021. The institution vide letter dated 09.03.2021 submitted its reply to the First Show Cause Notice.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 397th meeting held on 25th-26th March 2021 and the Committee decided as follows:-

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Committee on the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution and decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution Diana College of Education, Survey No. 68, (New No. 68/3, New Municipal Khata No. 12/68, Chokkanahalli Village, Yelahanka Hobli, Bengaluru North Taluk, Bengaluru District – 560064, Karnataka for B.Ed. programme for 1 basic unit of 50 students."

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NOW THEREFORE, the SRC decided to permit the institution i.e., **Diana College of Education, Survey No. 68, Chokkanahalli Village, Hege Nagar Main Road, Jakkur Post, Yelahanka Hobli, Bangalore-560064, Karnataka** for **B.Ed. course** run by **Diana Educational Trust, Bangalore, Karnataka** for continuation of recognition for **B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (one basic unit)** subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
 - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
 - III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
 - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
8. Further, the institution is required to fulfil all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.
9. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
10. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely: -
- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
 - b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
 - c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter:
 - d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
 - e. Fee charged from students.
 - f. Available infrastructural facilities.
 - g. Facilities added during the last quarter.
 - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
 - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
 - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
 - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.


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11. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
12. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
13. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.
