WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the institution **Goutham B.Ed. College, Allipur, Hospet Road, Bellary-583104, Karnataka** was granted recognition vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed/2005-2006/5344 dated 03.02.2006 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2005-2006.

AND WHEREAS, a letter has been received from Ambedkar Education Trust stating that the Goutham B.Ed College was run by Best Education Trust and that has been now undertaken by Ambedkar Tatva Education Trust and shifted the B.Ed. College to Bidar. The State Government has also given permission and University has also granted affiliation. The institution has requested SRC, NCTE to permit the institution to shifting of management and shifting of place from Bellary District to Bidar District. The institution has also submitted demand draft for Rs. 40,000/- for shifting.

AND WHEREAS, the matter relating to the change of management and shifting of institution from one district to another was considered by the SRC in its 178th meeting held on 13-14 July 2009 and decided to issue Show Cause Notice under Section 17 for shifting without prior permission of NCTE and also to call for details and documents of the institution. A notice was issued to the institution on 27.08.2009. The institution has submitted its written representation on 25.09.2009.

AND WHEREAS, the committee in its 189th meeting held on 25-26 February 2010 considered the reply to the Notice and decided not to permit the shifting of the institution, as there is no provision for shifting the institution from one District to another. A letter was sent to the institution on 07.04.2010.

AND WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 32 of the NCTE Act, 1993 (73 of 1993) the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2014 were notified on 01.12.2014 in supersession of the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure), Regulations, 2009.

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AND WHEREAS, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the duration of the B.Ed. course was increased from one year to two years and the existing institutions offering B.Ed. course, of one-year duration, were required to give their acceptance, in the form of an affidavit, for adherence of the NCTE Regulations, 2014.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dt. 28.01.2015 for its willingness of two units in B.Ed. course and adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 18.05.2015 for conducting **B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.**

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 316th meeting held during 07th & 08th July 2016 considered the matter and decided to issue Show Cause Notice under NCTE Act for the following deficiencies:-

1. **Land Documents is not given.**
2. **Processing fee is not paid.**
3. **BP is given but not approved by the competent authority.**
4. **No other documents are given.**
5. **Original FDRs and Approved Faculty list is not given.**
6. **Issue Show Cause Notice accordingly.**

AND WHEREAS, Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 18.07.2016.

AND WHEREAS, the Show Cause Notice dated 26.04.2019 issued to Goutham B.Ed. College has been received back undelivered. It is also noticed as per available records in file that a Show Cause Notice dated 18.07.2016 was sent to the institution. However, no reply has been received till date. An email has been sent on the email ID of the society. There is no email ID of the college as per available record in the file.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in 381th meeting held on 31st Oct & 1st Nov, 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue Final SCN in all such matters where reply to Show Cause Notice has not been submitted by the institution. Accordingly, Final Show Cause was issued on 29.11.2019. The institution did not submitted reply to the Final Show Cause Notice till date.

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AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 389th meeting held on 12th & 14th October, 2020 considered the matter and decided as under: -

“The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN) dated 29.11.2019.

1. The institution has failed in submission of written representation along with all required documents in response to Final Show Cause Notice.

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Goutham B.Ed. College, Allipur, Hospet Road, Bellary-583104, Karnataka** for conducting B.Ed course w.e.f. the 2020-21 academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.”

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby **withdraws recognition of Goutham B.Ed. College, Allipur, Hospet Road, Bellary-583104, Karnataka was granted recognition vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed/2005-2006/5344 dated 03.02.2006 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the next academic session starts after issuance of this order.**

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through “Online mode” available on NCTE’s website www.ncte-india.org, within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filling appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
