ORDER

WHEREAS, the institution namely Govt. D.I.E.T. Nalgonda, Nalgonda Village, Miryalaguda Road, Nalgonda Taluk, City & District-508001, Telangana run by District Institute of Education and Training, BTS Village, Miryalaguda Road, Nalgonda Taluk, City & District-508001, Telangana had submitted an application seeking grant of recognition of D.P.S.E course for two years duration for the academic year 2017-18 under Section 14/15 of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE through online on 30.06.2016. The institution submitted the hard copy of the application on 11.07.2015

2. AND WHEREAS, on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit submitted and the report received from VT and videography, and the certificate received from the affiliating university, LOI reply etc. the Committee is satisfied that the applicant fulfils the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulation including the Norms and Standards for the said teacher education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, financial resources, etc., for running the programme.

3. NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3) (a) of the NCTE Act 1993, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to Govt. D.I.E.T., Ward No. 15 B.T.S. Miryalaguda Road, Nalgonda, Municipality Nalgonda-508001, Telangana run by District Institute of Education and Training, BTS Village, Miryalaguda Road, Nalgonda Taluk, City & District-508001, Telangana for conducting (D.P.S.E) for two year duration with an intake of 50 students (one units) from the academic sessions 2020-2021 under Clause 7(16) of NCTE (Regulation Norms & Procedure) Regulation, 2014 subject to fulfillment of the following conditions for D.P.S.E programme of two year duration:-

(a) The institution shall adhere to the fulfillment of the provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014, as amended from time to time, and ensure the following before commencement of the session:-

- (i) The institution shall comply with various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, as amended from time to time.
- (ii) The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of Clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- (iii) The institution shall comply with condition laid down in clause 8(3) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014, as amended vide Notification on 29.04.2017. which provides as under:-

- **An institution, which has been recognised by the Council shall obtain accreditation from an accrediting agency identified by the Council within five years of the date of recognition.**
 - **All existing Teacher Education Institutions which have not been accredited so far or have not been accredited within five years from the date of its recognition shall be required to get themselves accredited by the aforesaid accrediting agency within a period of one year from the date of notification of these Regulations.**
 - **The accreditation once obtained shall be valid for a period of five years and the recognised and already accredited Teacher Education Institutions shall be required to get accreditation renewed by the agency identified for the purpose by the Council before the lapse of the earlier accreditation.**
- (iv) The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
- (v) The Norms for teaching staff in respect of their qualifications and experience shall be as per provisions of NCTE Regulations, 2014, as amended from time to time.

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, State Government etc. as applicable, and compliance of the following by the affiliating body, State Govt. and also the concerned recognized Institution:-

- (i) The affiliating body shall be required to verify the authenticity of the land & building documents submitted by the institution, with the required land & built up area as well as appointment of requisite teaching & non-teaching staff as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 before grant of affiliating to the institution.
- (ii) The affiliating body shall ensure that the norms including the norms of Faculty for offering D.P.S.E component of the programme as per curriculum of these programme in the University, is scrupulously observed.
- (iii) The affiliating body shall ensure that the institution is a composite institution as per definition of a "composite institution" given in the NCTE Regulations, 2014. If at any stage, it is found that the institution is not a composite institution, the recognition granted shall be treated as withdrawn and the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution. However, the existing stand-alone institutions.
- (iv) The NOC of the affiliating body and staff approval thereof submitted by the institution, if found fake, at any stage, the recognitions granted shall be treated as withdrawn, and the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution.

5. The institution shall submit a Self-Appraisal Report to the Regional Committee at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

6. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display as mandatory disclosure the following:-

- (i) Copy of Application Form
- (ii) Land and Building Particulars
- (iii) Staff Profile
- (iv) Recognition Order
- (v) Information regarding fulfilment of norms & standards and other conditions for the course.

7. In case, if the land is in the name of the Society/Trust, the land is to be transferred within six months from the date of recognition order in the name of the institution, failing which action shall be initiated for withdrawal of recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate about the same to the Regional Committee along with new land documents within the stipulated time.

8. The Educational Institution shall follow Uniform Accounting System as brought out by ICAI and accepted by the MHRD.

9. The Institution shall fill the GIS Application within one month from the date of issue of this order.

10. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules and Regulations, the Regional Committee shall withdraw recognition under provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

11. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
