Withdrawal ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution namely VJP College of Education, Trichy-Chennai Highway, Sirungar, Trichy-621105, Tamilnadu vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.TN/SEC/SRO/NCTE/2005-2006/4146 dt.22.11.2005 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2005-2006.

AND WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 32 of the NCTE Act, 1993 (73 of 1993) the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure), Regulations, 2014 were notified on 01.12.2014 in supersession of the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure), Regulations, 2009.

AND WHEREAS, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the duration of the B.Ed. course was increased from one year to two years and the existing institutions offering B.Ed. course, of one-year duration, were required to give their acceptance, in the form of an affidavit, for adherence of the NCTE Regulations, 2014.

AND WHEREAS, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014 and as per affidavit submitted by the institution dt.27.01.2015, the Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 14.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students each for (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16 subject to fulfilment of the conditions mentioned therein.

And whereas, Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution dt.24.04.2019 & dt.21.02.2019.

And whereas, in response to the Show Cause Notice, a letter dt. 15.05.2019 has been received from the Advocate of the institution whereby it has been requested to grant some additional time duration to fulfil all the conditions mentioned in the Show Cause Notice.

And whereas, the SRC in its 379th meeting held on 21st - 22nd August, 2019 considered the matter and decided as under: -

"The original files of the institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:

(i) The Committee perused the material available about the VJP college of education Trichy. It is an existing teacher education offering B.Ed. from 2005. When the SRC through a notice dated 21.2.2019 asked for the information to issue continuation of recognition order, instead of furnishing the information through their advocate the management expressed their inability to furnish the information and requested for some more time. As it is an existing institution it is not expected from the institution such a reply and hence the committee decided to withdraw the recognition.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to VJP College of Education, Trichy-Chennai Highway, Sirungar, Trichy-621105, Tamilnadu for conducting B.Ed. course w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of VJP College of Education, Trichy-Chennai Highway, Sirungar, Trichy-621105, Tamilnadu granted by SRC vide order no. F.TN/SEC/SRO/NCTE/2005-2006/4146 dt.22.11.2005 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the next academic session starts after issuance of this order.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through "Online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org, within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filling appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
