ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution namely Mythri College of Education, B.M. Nanjappa Layout, Bye-Pass Road, Near Sahyadri College, Shimoga - 577203, Karnataka run by Smt. Gangamma Veera Bhadra Shashtry Smaraka Trust, Shimoga-577203, Karnataka vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APSO4068/B.Ed/2005-2006/4891 dt. 22.12.2005 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2005-2006.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dated 19.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 15.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (Two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, the institution vide letter dated 19.1.2015 sought for the reduction from basic units (100 students) to one basic unit (50 students). Accordingly, a corrigendum was issued on 15.07.2015 to the institutions.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. As per the decision of SRC a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 13.02.2019.

AND WHEREAS, the institution vide letter dated 08.03.2019 submitted reply to the show cause notice. The SRC in its 378th Meeting held on 25th & 26th July, 2019 and the Committee decided to issue Final SCN to the Institution.

AND WHEREAS, as per the decision of SRC a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 30.07.2019. The institution vide letter date 13.08.2019 submitted its reply to the Final Show Cause Notice.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was finally considered by the SRC in its 380th meeting held from 18th – 19th September, 2019 decided as under:-

"On the perusal of the original documents and records made available in the file. The Committee noted that the institution was transferred from Smt. Gangamma Veera Bhadra Shashtry Memorial Trust, Shimoga to the Management Swamy Vivekananda Vidya Samasthe @, Shivamogga Road, Shikaripura Dist, Karnataka with the prior permission from the Government of Karnataka vide letter dated 1.4.2010 and

Kuvempu University vide letter dated 6.4.2010, therefore, the Committee decided that the continuation order be issued to Mythri College of Education, B.M. Nanjappa Layout, Bye-Pass Road, Near Sahyadri College, Shimoga -577203, Karnataka for B.Ed programme for 1 unit (50 students)."

NOW THEREFORE, this order is issued permitting the institution **Mythri College of Education, Survey No. 120/1, 129/1, Ward No. 16, Nanjappa Layout, 2nd Cross, Shimoga, Municipality, Shimoga-577203, Karnataka** run by **Swamy Vivekananda Vidya Samasthe ®, Shivamogga Road, Shikaripura Dist, Karnataka** for continuation of conducting B.Ed course of two years duration with an intake of 50 students (1 basic unit) subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
 - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
 - III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
 - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
6. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc as applicable.
7. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
8. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-
- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
 - b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
 - c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter:
 - d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
 - e. Fee charged from students;
 - f. Available infrastructural facilities;
 - g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
 - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
 - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
 - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.

- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
9. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
10. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
11. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued thereunder, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provision of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.
