WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

WHEREAS, recognition u/s14 of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, B.S. Bugudi B.Ed. College, Plot No.1, Tandur Village & Post Office, Tandur Taluk & City, Rangareddy District-501141, Telangana run by B S Bugudi Educational Society, Plot No.1, Chengeshpur Road, Tandur Village & Post Office, Tandur Taluk & City, Rangareddy District-501141, Telangana vide SRC (NCTE) order no. SRO/NCTE /SRCAPP14218/B.Ed./TS /2016-2017/84084 dated 12.04.2016 for conducting B.Ed. Programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (1 unit) from the academic session 2016-2017.

2. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 406th meeting held on 19th January 2022 has considered the matter and decided to conduct inspection of the institution. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC, a letter was issued to the institution on 04.02.2022. The inspection of institution was conducted on 27.04.2022 and Visiting Team Report was received on 10.05.2022.

3. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 411th meeting held on 23rd & 24th May 2022 has considered the matter and decided to issue a letter. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a letter was issued to the institution on 04.06.2022. The institution vide letter dated 16.06.2022 has submitted a reply to the Letter.

4. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 414th Meeting held on 26th – 27th September 2022 considered the matter and deficiencies in reply to Letter decided as under: -

"The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The SRC constituted a Sub-Committee to visit the institution to verify the infrastructural and instructional facilities. The Committee visited the institution on 27.04.2022 and observed as follows:-

- 1. Seven staff members out of 10 members were present but when the individual signatures verified with the attendance Registers are not tally. The signatures that are taken on the date of visit. To this effect the secretary and Principal of the college have also gave a written statement that they are not tallying. To this effect copies of attendance register / acquittance registers / signatures taken on the day of visit have been taken.*
- 2. Out of 50 (one unit) students admitted only 22 students were present in the college at the time of visit but the students were silent when asked questions. It is an indication that they are not at all attending the college. Present in student attendance register shown 95-97%. Attendance marked at present. Even on the date of visit only 22 students were present. For them also attendance was not marked correctly. The absent marked for these who were present, and present marked for those not attended. The Principal and staff / management is not serious on this important practice. The students were made silent when asked the other general questions on staff attendance, teaching of lessons etc.*

3. When VT asked for information about D.El.Ed programme, the management showed the almanac for 2021-22 and it is declared vacation for them. Hence, details about D.Ed. are not provided by the management.

4. Library resources are not adequate.
5. E.T. Lab is not adequate.
6. Facilities for language learning lab not provided.
7. Science Lab is not adequate.
8. Sports facilities not provided.
9. Salary is not being paid through account.
10. Website of the institution is not functional
11. Non-teaching staff not shown.
12. Safe drinking water not provided.
13. Salary to staff is not being disbursed through bank account.

In terms of report given by the Committee Show Cause Notice dated 04.06.2022 was issued to the institution to submit explanation/documents. The institution has submitted its reply vide letter dated 16.06.2022. The Committee perused the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies.

1. The institution has submitted photocopy of faculty of 1+9 members however the date of appointment and experience have not been mentioned in the faculty list.
2. The institution has declared that they are not maintaining students' attendance register.
3. The institution has not submitted bank statement for the disbursement of salaries.
4. The Sub-Committee constituted by the SRC visited the institution on 27.4.2022 and they found that only 22 students were present, the faculty available at the institution are not the same who are in approved list of the University.
5. The infrastructural and instructional facilities are very poor. The functioning of the institution is not academically in congenial environment.

Hence the recognition granted to **B.S. Bugudi B.Ed. College, Plot/Khasara No.1, Tandur Village & Post, Tandur Taluk & City, Rangareddi District – 501141, Telangana for B.Ed. course is withdrawn under Section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic year 2023-2024. On withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body from the next academic session stands withdrawn”.**


5. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **B.S. Bugudi B.Ed. College, Plot/Khasara No.1, Tandur Village & Post, Tandur Taluk & City, Rangareddi District – 501141, Telangana** run by **B S Bugudi Educational Society, Plot No.1, Chengeshpur Road, Tandur Village & Post Office, Tandur Taluk & City, Rangareddy District-501141, Telangana** for conducting **B.Ed. Programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **50 students (one unit)** from the academic year **2023-2024**. On withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body from the next academic session stands withdrawn.

6. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -



"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

7. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
