WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution namely **Vocational Education Society's D.Ed College, Post Box No. 86, Behind P&T Colony, Gulbarga District-585102, Karnataka** run by **Vocational Education Society, Gulbarga District, Karnataka** vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/D.Ed/2006-2007/2425 dt. 10.05.2007 for conducting D.Ed course of two-years duration with an annual intake of 50 students from the academic session 2006-2007.

AND WHEREAS, The institution vide letter dated 09.12.2019 requested the SRC for **closure of D.El.Ed Course**.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 383rd Meeting held on 7th, 8th and 9th January 2020 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The Committee decided that to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Vocational Education Society's D.Ed College, Post Box No. 86, Behind P&T Colony, Gulbarga District-585102, Karnataka** for conducting D.Ed. course under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the request of the institution vide its letter dated 09.12.2019. However, the FDRs towards Reserve Fund and Endowment Fund/ No Objection Certificate (NOC) for encashment of FDRs will be issued by the Regional Director on the submission of the following:

- (a) **NOC from the affiliating body.**
- (b) **NOC from the staff/faculty.**
- (c) **Resolution of the management to the effect for closure of the course**

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
