WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution namely Rural B.Ed. College, Aurad(B), Bidar District- 585326 Karnataka vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed/2005-2006/5289 dt. 31.01.2006 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2005-2006.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dated 19.06.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. Thereafter, provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 01.07.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16. On 14/07/2015, the institution submitted a letter dated 10.07.2015 with the request to reduce the intake from 100 students (2 units) to 50 students (1 unit). Subsequently the SRC on the request of the institution reduced the intake from 100 students (2 units) to 50 students (1 unit) vide Corrigendum order dated 15.07.2015.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 298<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 08<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> January, 2016 considered the matter and decided as under:-

1. They have D.El.Ed also.
2. Land title is there. Land area is adequate for the two programmes.
3. Collect balance of fee and cause inspection for shifting of B.Ed.
4. Ask VT to collect all relevant documents.

AND WHEREAS, as per the decision of SRC a letter was issued to the institution on 20.05.2016. *The institution has not submitted its reply till date.*

AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by the SRC in its 373<sup>rd</sup> meeting held from 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> March, 2019 and the Committee decided as under:-

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The institution has not responded to the Show Cause Notice served till date.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition under Section 17 (1) of the NCTE Act.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Rural B.Ed. College, Aurad(B), Bidar District- 585326 Karnataka** for B.Ed course with on the grounds mentioned above.

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website [www.ncte-india.org](http://www.ncte-india.org) within 60 days from the date of issue of this order.
