WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely Sree Raghavendra Vidyalayam, Plot/Khasara No. 500,506,507,508, Plot No. 25,26,27,28,29,42,43,44, Near Darga, Perkit Village, Armoor Post, Taluk & city, Nizamabad District – 503224, Telangana run Sree Narayana Educational Society, Plot No. 1-12-14 & 15, Chota Bazar, Armoor Village & Post, Armoor Taluk & City, Nizamabad District – 503224, Telangana. vide SRC order SRO/NCTE/SRCAPP2883/B.Ed/TS/2016-17/84867 dt. 02.05.2016 for conducting (B.Ed.) course of two-year duration from the academic session 2016-17 with an annual intake of 100 students (2 units).

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed before SRC in its 347th meeting held on 16th & 17th November 2017 the Committee considered the matter and decided as under;

1. The basic direction of the court is to the State Govt (to grant permission u/s 20 of the APed. Act) and to the Affiliating Body (to give affiliation).
2. As regards the references to deficiencies the court has asked SRC to examine and decide accordingly to the 2014 Regulations.
- 3.1 The State Govt has listed specific deficiencies in this case *"No faculty member is having 3 years of teaching experience in the institution, as per the NCTE norms. Moreover, the Management has provided built up area of 1600 Sq.Mtrs only for B.Ed with an intake of 100 students, which is not sufficient to run the B.Ed course a it should have been 2000 Sq.Mtrs."*
Issue SCN to the college for reply.
- 3.2 Give 2-months' time to reply.
4. Put up in end- Jan 18.

Accordingly, as per decision of SRC show cause notice was issued to the institution on 28.11.2017 and letter to the Education Department was sent on 08.12.2017. The institution submitted its reply along with documents on 30.01.2018.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 355th meeting held on 31st January 2018 considered the matter and decided as under;

1. We are busy dealing with the new application cases because of the Supreme Court prescribed dateline of 3.3.18.
2. This 'enquiry' case can wait.
3. Put up after 3.3.18



As per the decision of SRC the matter was placed before SRC in its 3459th meeting held on 17th – 18th May, 2018 and the Committee decided as under;

1. WE have issued FR for B.Ed. (2 units) w.e.f. 2016-17 on 2.5.16.
2. Thereafter, the State Govt. of Telangana raised two allegations.
 - (i) No Faculty Members has 3 years' experience as required in NCTE Norms.
 - (ii) The built-up area is short by 480.58 sq.mts.
3. The enquiry into this matter has thrown up the following facts:
 - (i) The NCTE norms do not prescribe any experience period for Faculty Members, They only prescribe a 10 year experience period for Principals, There is a prescription about equivalence of degrees which states, 'MA+B.Ed+3 year experience =M.A + M.Ed Possibly, this has caused some confusion.
 - (ii) As regards built-up area, they have submitted a duly approved BCC to show a built-up area up of 2080 sq.mts which is more than adequate for B.Ed. (2 units)
4. Let us clarify the position accordingly to the State Government.
5. Inform the University.
6. This college has also as B.P.Ed Programmed, RD should check and report whether they have adequate built-up area for that.

Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a letter was sent to the Special Chief Secretary to Government on 25.05.2018. Again, the office has received a letter from Smt. Ranjeev R. Acharya, Special Chief Secretary to Government, Government of Telangana on 24.07.2018.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, The SRC in its 365th meeting held on 31st October – 01st November 2018 considered the matter and decided as under:-

1. We have decided the B.Ed case finally on 18.05.2018.
2. we had then incidentally referred to the B.P.Ed case and asked Regional Director to check whether the built-up area for that is adequate.
3. The B.P.Ed. case (and, not the B.Ed. case) should have been put up.
4. The position is still not clear.
5. We have to go into Sy.No. details because there are discrepancies in the Sy.No. listed in the Affidavit, Building Plan, BCC, and the VTI Report.
6. We must ask the Vidyalayam itself to give coursewise details of Sy. No., land areas, built-up areas. Wherever same lands and/or buildings cover both B.Ed. + B.P.Ed., clear earmarking of lands/buildings for each course should be given. Please collect information accordingly and resubmit.

Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a letter was issued to the institution on 27.11.2018. The institution has not submitted reply to the latter till date.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, a letter dated 12.01.2021 was received from Telangana University regarding withdraw the recognition of some colleges/institutions from the list of B.Ed. colleges of the Telangana University for the academic year 2020-2021 on the ground of non-fulfilment of NCTE norms and Regulations.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 394th meeting held on January 27-28, 2021 and the Committee decided as follows: -

The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The Committee observed that the institution has not replied to the letter issued on 27.11.2018.

In addition to the above, the Committee perused the letter received from the Registrar, Telangana University regarding not extending the affiliation to some colleges / institutions for the academic year 2020-2021 on the ground of non-fulfilment of NCTE norms and Regulations.

The **Sree Raghavendra Vidyalayam, Plot/Khasara No. 500,506,507,508, Plot No. 25,26,27,28,29,42,43,44, Near Darga, Perkit Village, Armoor Post, Taluk & city, Nizamabad District – 503224, Telangana** is one among the colleges which were not affiliated for the academic year 2020-21 by the Telangana University.

In view of the non - submission of reply to the letter dt 27.11.2018 and also the letter received from the Registrar, Telangana University, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Sree Raghavendra Vidyalayam, Plot/Khasara No. 500,506,507,508, Plot No. 25,26,27,28,29,42,43,44, Near Darga, Perkit Village, Armoor Post, Taluk & city, Nizamabad District – 503224, Telangana** for conducting B.Ed course w.e.f. the 2020-2021 academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

8. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Sree Raghavendra Vidyalayam, Plot/Khasara No. 500,506,507,508, Plot No. 25,26,27,28,29,42,43,44, Near Darga, Perkit Village, Armoor Post, Taluk & city, Nizamabad District – 503224, Telangana** run by **Sree Narayana Educational Society, Plot No. 1-12-14 & 15, Chota Bazar, Armoor Village & Post, Armoor Taluk & City, Nizamabad District – 503224, Telangana** for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students w.e.f. academic session 2020-2021 onwards.

9. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of



employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

10. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
