**WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

WHEREAS the recognition was granted to the institution namely **New Horizon College of Education, 100 ft. Road, HAL II Stage, Indiranagar, Bangalore 560008, Karnataka** run by **New Horizon College of Education, 100 ft. Road, HAL II Stage, Indiranagar, Bangalore 560008, Karnataka** vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.KAR/B.Ed./06/SRO/NCTE/2000-2001/944 dt. 11.07.2000 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2000-2001.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dt 19.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 27.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 (one basic unit) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, the matter of the institution was placed before the SRC in its 374<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 9<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> April 2019. The Committee considered the matter and decided to issue a Show Cause Notice to the institution to submit the compliance. Accordingly, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 23.04.2019. Now, the institution vide an e- mail dt 13.01.2021 requested for closure its B.Ed course from the academic session 2020-21.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 394<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup>-28<sup>th</sup> January 2021 considered the matter and decided as under:-

*"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993; Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -*

*The Committee agreed to close down the institution as requested by the management by its letter dt 13.01.2021 by withdrawing the recognition granted to **Horizon College of Education, 100 ft. Road, HAL II Stage, Indiranagar, Bangalore 560008, Karnataka** for conducting B.Ed course under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic session 2020-2021.*

*However, the FDRs towards Reserve Fund and Endowment Fund/ No Objection Certificate (NOC) for encashment of FDRs will be issued by the Regional Director on the submission of the following:*

- (a) NOC from the affiliating body.
- (b) NOC from the staff/faculty.
- (c) Resolution of the management to the effect for closure of the course"

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of **New Horizon College of Education, 100 ft. Road, HAL II Stage, Indiranagar, Bangalore 560008, Karnataka** run by **New Horizon College of Education, 100 ft. Road, HAL II Stage, Indiranagar, Bangalore 560008, Karnataka** for conducting B.Ed. programme of two-year duration with an annual intake of 50 students (1 unit) w.e.f. the next academic session i.e., 2020-2021 onwards.



Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

**“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”**

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website [www.ncte-india.org](http://www.ncte-india.org) within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
