## TO BE PUBLISHED IN GAZETTE OF INDIA PART III SECTION 4 WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely Anjuman College of Education, Anjuman Abad, Bhatkal, Uttara Kannada District-581320, Karnataka run by Anjuman Hami-E-Muslimeen, Bhatkal, Uttara Kannada District, Karnataka vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/2007-2008/15039 dt. 20.11.2007 for conducting Secondary (B.Ed.) course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2007-2008.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dt 31.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 16.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, on 03.06.2016 a letter is received by this office from the institution regarding reduction of unit. The matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 26.02.2019. The institution submitted a letter received in SRC on 25.02.2019 requesting for reduction of intake from 2 units to 1 unit.

AND WHEREAS, the above matter was placed in its 374<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> April 2019 and the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 23.04.2019. The institution did not reply to Show Cause Notice till date.

**AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 388<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup>-15<sup>th</sup> September 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue Final SCN to all the institutions wherein Recognition was accorded by the SRC with the direction to submit all requisite documents. Accordingly, Final Show Cause was issued on 09.10.2020. The institution vide letter dated 24.10.2020 submitted its reply to the Final Show Cause Notice.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 394th meeting held on 27th-28th January 2021 considered the matter and decided as under:-

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The Committee considered the reply submitted by the institution on 09.10.2020 in respect to the Final Show Cause Notice and found the following deficiencies: -

- (i) The institution has submitted notarized copy of 'Record of R.T.C.' The institution is required to submit certified copy of land documents.
- (ii) The purpose for which land is being used is not mentioned in the LUC.
- (iii) The survey no., site area and multipurpose hall area is not mentioned in the building plan. The institution has not submitted original blueprint of the building plan.

- (iv) The institution has not submitted notarized copy of BCC approved by the competent authority.
- (v) The institution has not submitted Form "A" issued by the Branch Manager. The institution is required to submit Form "A" issued by the bank manager towards creation of FDR of Rs. 7 lakh & Rs. 5 lakhs towards Endowment Fund & Reserve Fund.
- (vi) The faculty list is submitted for eight faculty members, which is not sufficient for one basic unit of 50 students.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Anjuman College of Education, Anjuman Abad, Bhatkal, Uttara Kannada District-581320, Karnataka for conducting B.Ed course w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of Anjuman College of Education, Anjuman Abad, Bhatkal, Uttara Kannada District-581320, Karnataka run by Anjuman Hami-E-Muslimeen, Bhatkal, Uttara Kannada District, Karnataka for conducting B.Ed. programme of two-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students (2 units) w.e.f. the next academic session i.e., 2020-2021 onwards.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website <a href="www.ncte-india.org">www.ncte-india.org</a> within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
