**CONTINUATION ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, the Appellate Authority vide Order No.F.No.42-138/2001Appeal/20216 dated 19.04.2002 reversed the Order appealed against and granted recognition to **St. Jude's College of Education for Women, Vikarabad, Ranga Reddy, Andhra Pradesh** with an annual intake of B.Ed. course of 100 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dated 19.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 31.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.


3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in 381<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 31<sup>st</sup> Oct & 1<sup>st</sup> Nov, 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted requisite documents/VT Reports accompanied with requisite documents in respond to RPRO issued by the SRC. Accordingly, First Show Cause was issued on 25.11.2019. The management of the institution submitted reply vide letter dated 11.01.2020 to the First Show Cause Notice.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 384<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> February 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 11.03.2020. The management of the institution submitted its reply vide letter dated 20.03.2020 to the Final Show Cause Notice.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the mater was further considered by the SRC in its meeting 388<sup>th</sup> held on 14<sup>th</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup> September 2020 and the committee decided to issue Last Reminder Letter. Accordingly, a Last Reminder Letter was issued to the institution on 24.09.2020 the institution management of the was submitted reply on 22.10.2020.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 410<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 25<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup> April 2022 considered the matter and decided to withdraw the recognition. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC Withdrawal order was issued to the institution vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APS00017/B.Ed./TS /2022/133043-133046 dated 27.07.2022.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has filed Writ Petition before Hon'ble High Court of Delhi for bearing W.P (C) No. 15040/2022 & CM APPLs. 46432/2022 titled as St Judes College of Education Versus National Council for Teacher Education Whereby the Hon'ble High Court has directed that: -



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***"The NCTE is directed to reflect the status of the Petitioner as a recognised institution for the year 2022-23 on its website and send an intimation to Petitioner's affiliating university and concerned State Government. The above direction shall be carried out within one week from today.***

***The Appellate Committee of NCTE shall also endeavor to dispose of Petitioner's appeal as expeditiously as possible, not later than three months from today"***

8. **AND WHEREAS**, in compliance of order dated 31.10.2022, the Regional Director, SRC has already passed an order dated 09.11.2022 vide order no. File No.SRO/NCTE /APSO0017/B.Ed./TS/2022/136666-136668 regarding entitled to participate in the consulting for academic session 2022-2023.

9. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 417<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> December, 2022 considered the matter and Committee decided as under:-

***"In Compliance of order dated 31.10.2022 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi in W.P (C) No. 15040/2022 titled as St Judes College of Education versus NCTE & Anr., the Regional Director has issued order dated 09.11.2022, wherein the institution is permitted to participate in process of counselling for the academic session 2022-2023. While ratifying the decision taken by the Regional Director the Committee directed the office of the RD to write a letter to the Affiliating University to ensure that the institution has complied with NCTE Regulations, 2014 or not. The Registrar of the affiliating university be requested to send a compliance report in this regard"***

10. **AND WHEREAS**, according, a letter dated 13.12.2022 was issued to The Registrar Osmania University Telangana in compliance of direction of SRC.

11. **AND WHEREAS**, aggrieved by the order of the SRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order No. 89-217/E-266821/2022 Appeal/9<sup>th</sup> Meeting, 2022 APPLSRC202214443 dated 30.11.2022 appeal remand back the order appealed against. The institution has submitted reply of Appeal Remand Back Case received on 15.12.2022.

12. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 418<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 16<sup>th</sup> December 2022 considered the matter and decided as under:-

***"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made were made: -***

***The Committee on the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution St. Jude's College of Education for***



***Women, Survey No. 15 (103), Ward No.6, Vikarabad, Ranga Reddy District- 501101, Telangana for B.Ed. programme for 1 basic unit of 50 students."***

**13. NOW THEREFORE,** this order is issued permitting the institution i.e. **St. Jude's College of Education for Women, Survey No. 15 (103), Ward No.6, Vikarabad, Ranga Reddy District- 501101, Telangana** for continuation of recognition for **B.Ed. Programme** for two years duration **(1 basic unit) of 50 students** subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

**14.** Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.

**15.** The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

**16.** The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
- b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter:
- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;



- e. Fee charged from students;
- f. Available infrastructural facilities;
- g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.


17. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.

18. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.

19. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.


