WHEREAS, recognition u/s 14 (3)(a) of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely Sri S. Kariappa College of Education, R.E.S. Campus, M.G. Road, Kanakapura, Bangalore, Rural District, Karnataka – 562117 run by The Rural Education Society, Kanakapura, Bangalore Rural District, Karnataka vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2005-2006/4947 dt. 24.12.2005 for conducting Secondary (B.Ed.) course of one year duration from the academic session 2005-2006 with an annual intake of 100 students.

- 2. AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit on 10.06.2015 for its willingness for B.Ed. course and adherence of provisions of new Regulations. Thereafter, a Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 01.07.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 Students (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.
- 3. AND WHEREAS, the status of issuance of SCN/FSCN was considered by the Sub-Committee constituted by the SRC in its meeting held on 22ndOct, 2019. The Sub-Committee noted that institutions have not submitted requisite documents or only part reply has been submitted. The Sub-Committee decided to issue SCN in all such cases who did not submitted reply. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC First Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 24.10.2019. The institution did not submit any reply to First Show Cause Notice.
- 4. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 406th meeting held on 19th January 2022 has considered the matter and decided to issue a Final show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 03.02.2022. The institution has submitted reply of Final Show Cause Notice on 09.03.2022.
- 5. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 409th Meeting held on 29th & 30th March 2022 considered the matter and decided to Withdraw the recognition order of the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision Withdrawal order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APS03104/B.Ed./KA/2022/131334-131338 dated 11.04.2022 was issued to the institution.
- 6. AND WHEREAS, the institution has filed Writ Petition before Hon'ble High Court of Delhi for bearing W.P (C) No. 15159/2022 & CM APPLs. 46882/2022 titled as Sri S Kariappa College of Education Versus National Council for Teacher Education Whereby the Hon'ble High Court has directed that: -

"Respondents are directed to update the status of Petitioner, within a period of one week from today, and send an intimation in respect thereof to the affiliating university of Petitioner as well as to the concerned Department of Education to enable them to participate in counselling and admission process for academic session 2022-23."

- 7. **AND WHEREAS**, in compliance of order dated 02.11.2022, the Regional Director, SRC has already passed an order dated 16.11.2022 No. SRO/NCTE/APSO3104/B.Ed./KA/2022/136830-136832 for confirmation.
- 8. AND WHEREAS, aggrieved by the order of the SRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order No. 89-179/E-258797/2022 Appeal/9th Meeting, 2022 APPLSRC202214408 dt. 30.11.2022 appeal remand back the order appealed against. The institution has submitted reply of appeal remand back case on 13.12.2022.
- 9. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 418th Meeting held on 16th December, 2022 considered the matter and decided as follows: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Committee on the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution Sri S. Kariyappa College of Education, Survey No. 248, 250/2, RES Campus, M.G. Road, Kanakapura, Ramangara District, Karnataka-562117 for B.Ed. programme 1 basic unit of 50 students."

- 10. NOW THEREFORE, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e., Sri S. Kariyappa College of Education, Survey No. 248, 250/2, RES Campus, M.G. Road, Kanakapura, Ramangara District, Karnataka-562117 run by The Rural Education Society, Survey No. 248, 250/2, RES Campus, M.G. Road, Kanakapura, Ramangara District, Karnataka-562117 for Continuation of recognition for B.Ed. programme for two years duration with an annual intake of 1 basic unit of 50 students subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:-
 - I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
 - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
 - III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
 - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
- 11. Further, the institution is required to fulfil all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.
- 12. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

 - f. Available infrastructural facilities.
 - g. Facilities added during the last quarter.
 - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
 - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
 - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information if it so desires.
 - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
- 14. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
- 15. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
- 16. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
