WHEREAS, recognition u/s 14 (3)(a) of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely Amitha B.Ed. College, C.A. No. 2, 3rd Main, West of Chord Road, 2nd Stage, Mahalakshmipuram, Bangalore, Karnataka-560086 run by Ambedkar Memorial Society, Bangalore, Karnataka vide order no. F./SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2004-2005/8636 dt. 25.11.2004 for Secondary (B.Ed.) course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2004-2005.

- AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 268th meeting held on 04th 05th June, 2014 has considered 2. the matter and decided to withdraw the recognition. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a withdrawal no. F.SRO/NCTE/APS02174/B.Ed/KA/2014-15/58886 dated 07.08.2014 was issued to the institution.
- AND WHEREAS, aggrieved by the order of the SRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order no. F.No.89-104/2015 Appeal/8th Meeting-2015/14656 dated 23.09.2015 appeal reverses the orders.
- AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit for its willingness for B.Ed. course and adherence of provisions of new Regulations. Thereafter, a Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 17.02.2016 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 Students (one basic unit) from the academic session 2015-16.
- AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 304th Meeting held on 19th & 20th February. 2016 has considered the matter and decided to restoration of the recognition. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC the recognition accorded to Amitha B.Ed. College, C.A. No. 2, 3rd main, West of Chord Road, 2nd Stage, Mahalakshmipuram, Bangalore, Karnataka-560086 is hereby restored vide order no. F.No./SRC/NCTE/APSO2174/B.Ed./KA/2016/87325 dt. 13.07.2016.
- AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the Committee decided 6. that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 27.03.2019. The institution vide letter dated 15.05.2019 submitted its reply to the show cause notice.
- AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered in 379th meeting of SRC held on 21st and 22nd 7. and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 28.08.2018. The institution has submitted its reply to Final Show Cause Notice on 17.09.2019.
- AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 384th meeting held on 12th 13th February, 2020 has considered the matter and decided to withdraw the recognition. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC a Withdrawal Order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APSO2174/B.Ed./KA/2020/115815-5821 dated 06.03.2020 was issued to the institution.
- AND WHEREAS, aggrieved by the order of the SRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order no. F.No.89-254/E-

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 419th Meeting held on 13th January, 2023 has considered the 10. matter and decided as follows: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Committee on the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution Amitha B.Ed. College, C.A. # 2, 3rd Main, Nagapura Ward No. 67. Mahalakshmipuram, Bangalore-560086, Karnataka for B.Ed. programme. 1 basic unit of 50 students.

The Committee further decided that the above said decision will be subject to the outcome of writ petition pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in respect of Performance Appraisal Report (PAR)."

- NOW THEREFORE, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e., Amitha B.Ed. College, 11. C.A. #2, 3rd Main, Nagapura Ward No. 67, Mahalakshmipuram, Bangalore-560086, Karnataka run by Ambedkar Memorial Society, C.A. # 2, 3rd Main, Nagapura Ward No. 67, Mahalakshmipuram, Bangalore-560086, Karnataka for Continuation of recognition for B.Ed. programme for two years duration with an annual intake of 1 basic unit of 50 students subject to the outcome of writ petition pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in respect of Performance Appraisal Report (PAR) fulfilment of the following conditions: -
 - The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with I. Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
 - The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the П. NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
 - The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body III. in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
 - The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by IV. affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
- Further, the institution is required to fulfil all such other requirements as may be prescribed by 12. other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.
- The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern 14. Regional Committee, covering, inter - alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely: -M Genny

- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information if it so desires.
- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
- 15. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
- 16. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
- 17. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
