CONTINUATION ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition u/s 14 (3)(a) of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely **Taj College of education, Shaik Roja, Behind Checkpost, Aland Road, Gulbarga District-585101, Karnataka** run by **Karnataka Educational and Welfare Trust, Gulbarga District, Karnataka** vide order no. F./SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2005-2006/5060 dt. 03.01.2006 for conducting Secondary (B.Ed.) course of one year duration from the academic session 2005-2006 with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit on 31.01.2015 for its willingness for B.Ed. course and adherence of provisions of new Regulations. Thereafter, a Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 27.05.2015 for conducting **B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 Students (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.**

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 29.05.2019. The institution did not submit reply to the Show Cause Notice.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was further considered by the Sub-Committee constituted by the SRC as per its decided taken in 380th meeting. The Sub-Committee of the SRC decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to all such institution where reply to SCN has not been submitted by the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a final show cause notice was issued to the institution on 11.10.2019. The institution has submitted reply on 02.11.2019.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 383rd Meeting held on 07th to 09th January, 2020 has considered the matter and decided to withdraw the recognition. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a withdrawal order vide no. F.SRO/NCTE/APSO3103/B.Ed./KA/2019/114031-4037 dated 20.01.2020 was issued to the institution.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, aggrieved by the order of the SRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order no. 89-268/E-199214/2021 Appeal/ 22nd Meeting, 2021 APPLSRC202114123 dated 26.11.2021 appeal confirmed case.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has filed Writ Petition before Hon'ble High Court of Delhi bearing W.P (C) No. 680/2022 & CM APPL. 1950/2022 titled as **Taj College of Education Versus National Council for Teacher Education & Anr.** The Institution vide letter dated

08.06.2022 has submitted reply alongwith documents direction passed by Hon'ble High Court on dated 24.05.2022 in W.P. (C) No. 680/2022 & CM APPL. 1950/2022.

8. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 412th meeting held on 05th & 06th July, 2022 considered the matter and decided to issue Last reminder (Letter) to the institution. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC Last reminder (Letter) was issued to the institution on 21.07.2022. The institution has submitted its reply on 21.07.2022 & 01.10.2022.

9. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 415th Meeting held on 03rd & 04th November, 2022 has considered the matter and decided to withdraw the recognition. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Withdrawal Order No. F.SRC/NCTE/APS03103/B.Ed./{KA}/2022/136913-136917 was issued to the institution on 17.11.2022.

10. **AND WHEREAS**, aggrieved by the order of the SRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order No. 89-266/E-282311/2022 Appeal/10th Meeting, 2022 APPLSRC202214492 dt. 21.12.2022 appeal remand back the order appealed against. The institution has submitted reply of appeal remand back case dt. 26.12.2022.

11. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 419th Meeting held on 13th January, 2023 has considered the matter and decided as follows: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Committee on the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution Taj College of Education, Survey No. 98/1, Near Aland Check Post, Aland Road, Kalaburagi District-585101, Karnataka for B.Ed. programme, 2 basic units of 50 students each."


12. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e., **Taj College of Education, Survey No. 98/1, Near Aland Check Post, Aland Road, Kalaburagi District-585101, Karnataka** run by **Karnataka Educational and Welfare Trust, Survey No. 98/1, Near Aland Check Post, Aland Road, Kalaburagi District-585101, Karnataka** for Continuation of recognition for **B.Ed. programme** for two years duration with an annual intake of **2 basic units of 50 students each** subject to fulfilment of the following conditions: -

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.




- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
13. Further, the institution is required to fulfil all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.
14. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
15. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely: -
- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
 - b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
 - c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter:
 - d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
 - e. Fee charged from students.
 - f. Available infrastructural facilities.
 - g. Facilities added during the last quarter.
 - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
 - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
 - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information if it so desires.
 - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
16. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
17. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
18. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued there under, the institution will render itself



vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.
