WHEREAS, recognition u/s 14 (3)(a) of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely Sri T. V. Venkataswamy College of Education, Madhugiri, Tumkur District, Karnataka-572132 vide order no. F.KAR/B.Ed./25/SRO/NCTE/2000-2001/1057 dt. 13.07.2000 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year duration from the academic session 2000-2001 with an annual intake of 100.

- 2. AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit on 09.01.2014 for its willingness for B.Ed. course and adherence of provisions of new Regulations. Thereafter, a Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 30.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 Students (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.
- 3. AND WHEREAS, the institution has submitted a request letter on 14.10.2015 for granting recognition of our college with an annual intake of one basic unit of 50 students. Accordingly, as per the request of the institution a Corrigendum was issued to the institution vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APSO3481/B.Ed./KA/2015-2016/77301 dt. 03.11.2015 for grants of recognition to the institution for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 for one basic unit from the academic session 2015-2016.
- 4. AND WHEREAS, the matter regarding compliance by the institution of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th Meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on dt. 12.02.2019. Thereafter, the institution has submitted reply of Show Cause Notice on 09.03.2019.
- 5. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 381st Meeting held on 31st October & 01st November, 2019 has considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 20.12.2019. The institution has submitted reply of Final Show Cause Notice on 18.03.2020.
- 6. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 401st meeting held on 11th -12th August 2021 has considered the matter and decided to withdraw the recognition. Accordingly, as per decision withdrawal order was issued vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APSO3481/B.Ed./{KA}/2021/1128445 dt. 28.08.2021 to the institution.
- 7. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 409th Meeting held on 29th & 30th March, 2022 has considered the matter and decided to issue a letter to the institution. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC a decision letter was issued to the institution dt. 19.04.2022.
- 8. AND WHEREAS, aggrieved by the order of the SRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order No. 89-82/E-243108/2022 Appeal/5th Meeting, 2022 APPLSRC202114164 dt. 12.07.3022 appeal remand back the order appealed against. The institution has submitted appeal remand back reply on 01.08.2022.

- 9. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 413th Meeting held on 22nd & 23rd August, 2022 has considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 05.09.2022. The institution has submitted its reply on 28.11.2022.
- 10. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 417th Meeting held on 01st & 02nd December, 2022 considered the matter and decided as follows: -

"The original files the Institution alongwith related documents. from Guidelines issued NCTE time NCTE 1993. Regulations Act. observations considered the SRC the following by and time carefully were made: -

The Committee on the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution Sri T.V. Venkateswamy College of Education, Khatha No. 694/26, Gowribidanur Road, Madhugiri, Tumkur District, Karnataka-572132 for B.Ed. programme, 1 basic unit of 50 students."

- 11. NOW THEREFORE, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e., Sri T.V. Venkateswamy College of Education, Khatha No. 694/26, Gowribidanur Road, Madhugiri, Tumkur District, Karnataka-572132 run by Madhugiri Education Society, Khatha No. 694/26, Gowribidanur Road, Madhugiri, Tumkur District, Karnataka-572132 for Continuation of recognition for B.Ed. programme for two years duration with an annual intake of 1 basic unit of 50 students subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:
 - I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
 - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
 - III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
 - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
- 12. Further, the institution is required to fulfil all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.
- 13. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- 14. - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information if it so desires.
- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
- 15. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
- 16. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
