CONTINUATION ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition u/s 14 (3)(a) of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely **Rajiv Gandhi College of Education, Ganesh Nagar, Kumbarwada Road, Bidar, Karnataka-585401** run by **Vishal Education Society, Bidar District, Karnataka** vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2006-2007/15693 dt. 06.12.2007 for conducting Secondary (B.Ed.) course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (Hundred) students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit on 04.02.2015 for its willingness for B.Ed. course and adherence of provisions of new Regulations. Thereafter, a Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 16.05.2015 for conducting **B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 Students (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.**

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has submitted a request letter dt. 29.06.2015 for running only one unit of 50 students. Accordingly, as per the request of the institution a corrigendum was issued to the institution vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APS05783/B.Ed./KA/2015/70373 dt. 21.07.2015 for grants recognition to the institution for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (one basic unit) from the academic session 2015-16.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its Meeting held on 22nd October, 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 30.10.2019. The institution has submitted its reply on 10.03.2021.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered by the Committee in its 401st Meeting held on 11th & 12th August 2021 and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 31.08.2021. The institution did not submit any reply to Final Show Cause Notice till date.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 405th meeting held on 11th -12th December 2021 has considered the matter and decided to withdraw the recognition. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC a withdrawal order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APS05783 /B.Ed./KA/2021/129718 dated 30.12.2021 was issued to the institution.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, aggrieved by the order of the SRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order No. 89-80/E-246531/2022 Appeal/5th Meeting, 2022 APPLSRC202214296 dated 12.07.2022 appeal deserved to be rejected. The operative part of the Appeal order is as under:-

"After perusal of the Memoranda of Appeal, Affidavit, documents on records and oral arguments advanced during the online hearing, Appeal Committee of the Council concluded that the SRC was justified in withdrawing recognition, therefore the instant appeal deserved to be rejected and the impugned withdrawal order is confirmed."

8. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has filed Writ Petition before Hon'ble High Court of Delhi bearing W.P (C) No. 12189/2022 & CM APPLs. 36472-36473/2022 titled as Rajiv Gandhi College of Education Versus National Council for Teacher Education & Anr. Whereby the Hon'ble High Court has directed that: -

"As the withdrawal order is of 30th December, 2021, in terms of second proviso to Section 17(1) of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993, the withdrawal order will take effect from the end of academic session 2022-23. Therefore, the Petitioner would be entitled to take admissions with respect to the academic session 2022-23, as has been noted in the withdrawal order itself in the following terms: -

*"NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Rajiv Gandhi College of Education, Ganesh Nagar, Kumbarwada Road, Bidar, Karnataka-585401** run by **Vishal Education Society, Bidar District, Karnataka** for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (1 basic unit) with effect from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023 onwards."*

9. **AND WHEREAS**, aggrieved by the order of the SRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order No. 89-80/E-246531/2022 Appeal/7th Meeting, 2022 APPLSRC202214296 dated 19.10.2022 appeal remand back the order appealed against. The institution has submitted reply of appeal remand back case on 01.11.2022.

10. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 417th meeting held on 01st – 02nd December, 2022 has considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a Final Show Cause Notice was to be issued to the institution. The institution has submitted reply on 12.12.2022.

11. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 418th Meeting held on 16th December, 2022 considered the matter and decided as follows: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

*The Committee on the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution **Rajiv Gandhi College of Education, Plot No. 6-A & 6-B, Situated at K.I.A.D.B. Kolar(K) Bidar Tq & Bidar District, Karnataka-585401** for B.Ed. programme, 1 basic unit of 50 students."*

12. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e., **Rajiv Gandhi College of Education, Plot No. 6-A & 6-B, Situated at K.I.A.D.B. Kolar(K) Bidar Tq & Bidar District, Karnataka-585401** run by **Vishal Education Society, Plot No. 6-A & 6-B, Situated at K.I.A.D.B. Kolar(K) Bidar Tq & Bidar District, Karnataka-585401** for Continuation of

recognition for **B.Ed. programme** for two years duration with an annual intake of **1 basic unit of 50 students** subject to fulfilment of the following conditions: -

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
 - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
 - III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
 - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
13. Further, the institution is required to fulfil all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.
14. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
15. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely: -
- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
 - b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
 - c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter:
 - d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
 - e. Fee charged from students.
 - f. Available infrastructural facilities.
 - g. Facilities added during the last quarter.
 - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
 - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
 - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information if it so desires.
 - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.




16. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.

17. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.

18. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provision of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.
