ORDER

WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 St Stephen Educational Society, II Floor, Satya Surya Complex, Dwarakanagar Village, Visakhapatnam Post and Taluk, Visakhapatnam District, Pin-530016, Andhra Pradesh had submitted an application on 06.10.2010 for grant of recognition for B.Ed course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students at Trinity College of Education, Khasara no. 139, Plot no. 2, Street no. 1, Singannabanda Village, Tagarapavalasa Post, Bheemunipatnam Taluk, Vishakhapatnam District, Pin-531162, Andhra Pradesh.

AND WHEREAS, the application was processed and the deficiency letter was issued to the institution on 10.12.2010. The institution not submitted reply on deficiency letter within 60 days as per stipulated in clause 7(1), Regulation 2009.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC considered the matter in its 201st meeting held on 22nd-23rd February, 2011 and on careful perusal of the original file of the institution and other related documents, NCTE Act 1993. Regulations and guidelines from time to time laid on the table, written representation from the institution, the Regional committee decided to reject the application on the following grounds:-

- The institution has not replied to the deficiency letter even after a lapse of stipulated time of 60 days as per clause 7(1), Regulation 2009.

AND WHEREAS, accordingly, rejection order was issued to the institution on 23.03.2011. The institution preferred to go for an appeal at NCTE, Hqrs. As per the directions of Hqrs vide letter received on 28.04.2011, the original document of the Institution was sent to Hqrs for appeal on 09.05.2011. NCTE Hqrs. vide order dt.06.07.2011 accepted the appeal and the order of SRC dt. 23.03.2011 reversed.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 210th meeting held on 22nd-23rd August, 2011 considered the Council directions dt. 06.07.2011 and decided to consider the reply dt. 11.03.2011 furnished by the institution to the deficiency letter to take appropriate decision in accordance with the provisions in the NCTE Act and regulations.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC considered the Council directions dt. 06.07.2011 and decided to consider the reply dt.11.03.2011 furnished by the institution to the deficiency letter to take appropriate decision in accordance with the provisions in the NCTE Act and regulations.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 213th meeting held on 06th-07th November, 2011 considered the written reply dtd. 21.02.2011 and other relevant documents submitted by the institution and decided to cause inspection ascertain infrastructural and instructional facilities under Section 14 of NCTE ACT. Accordingly, the inspection of the institution was fixed between 01st-04th February, 2012. The same was intimated to the institution on 24.01.2012. The inspection of the institution was conducted on 03.02.2012.

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AND WHEREAS; the SRC in its 219th meeting of SRC held on 15th-16th March, 2012 considered the VT report, VCD and all the relevant documentary evidences and decided to serve show cause notice under section 14(1) of NCTE Act. Accordingly, a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 04.04.2012. The institution has submitted its written representation on 25.04.2012.

AND WHEREAS, the matter is placed before SRC in its 223rd meeting held on 29th-31st May 2012 and SRC decided to issue letter of intent before grant of unconditional recognition. Accordingly, letter of intent was issued to the institution on 06.06.2012. The institution has submitted the written representation on 02.08.2012.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 231st meeting held on 22nd-23rd August, 2012 considered the reply of the institution and all the relevant documentary evidences and decided to serve Notice under NCTE Act. By seeing the website the institution has submitted written representation on 28.08.2012.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before SRC in its 232nd meeting held on 29th-31st August, 2012 and SRC decided to issue Formal Recognition.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to Trinity College of Education, Khasara no. 139, Plot no. 2, Street no. 1, Singannabanda Village, Tagarapuvallasa Post, Bheemunipatnam Taluk, Vishakhapatnam District, Pin-531162, Andhra Pradesh for conducting B.Ed Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2012-2013 under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009 subject, to fulfillment of the following conditions:

- I. The endowment fund of Rs.5 lakhs and reserve fund of Rs.3 lakhs kept in joint account with SRC, NCTE should be maintained always. Loan raising or mortgaging of FDRs shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
- V. Minority Certificate from the Principal Secretary, Department of Education, Government of Andhra Pradesh to be submitted within 3 months from the date of issue of this order.
2. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.
3. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

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4. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-
- Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution;
 - Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph;
 - Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last , quarter;
 - Names of students admitted during the current session along with qualification, percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
 - Fee charged from students;
 - Available infrastructural facilities;
 - Facilities added during the last quarter;
 - Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
 - The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires
 - Any wrong or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition
5. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
