WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **Sri, Venkateswara College of Education, Srinivasa Educational Academy, R.V.S Nagar, Tirupati Road, Muthirevulu, Chittoor, Andhra Pradesh-517127** run by **Srinivasa Educational Academy, R.V.S. Nagar, Muthirevulu Post, Chittoor, Andhra Pradesh** vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/2009/M.Ed./RO/12044 dt. 28.04.2009 for conducting M.Ed. course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 25 students from the academic session 2009-2010.

AND WHEREAS, enhancement of intake of 10 seats from existing 25 to 35 is permitted to **Shri Venkateswara College of Education, Srinivasa Educational Academy, R.V.S Nagar, Tirupati Road, Muthirevulu, Chittoor, Andhra Pradesh-517127** for **M.Ed. course** w.e.f. the session 2010-2011 vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/2010-2011/20702 of dt. 25.08.2010.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dt. 16.06.2015 for its willingness of two units in M.Ed. course with an annual intake of 50 students and adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 30.06.2015 for conducting **M.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students for one basic unit from the academic session 2015-16 with a condition to maintain.**

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 368th Meeting held during 27th & 28th December 2015 considered the matter and decided to issue Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution vide dt. 18.01.2019. Thereafter, the institution has submitted its reply vide letter dt. 25.01.2019.

AND WHEREAS, the institution has submitted a letter dt. 25.01.2019 had requested for closure of M.Ed. course.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 395th Meeting held on 25th & 26th February 2021 and considered the matter as under: -

"The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

1. The Committee agreed to close down the institution as requested by the management by its letter dt 25.01.2019 by withdrawing the recognition granted to **Sri Venkateswara College of Education, Srinivasa Educational Academy, R.V.S. Nagar, Tirupati Road, Muthirevulu, Chittoor-517127, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting M.Ed. course under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 from the next academic session i.e., 2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

However, the FDRs towards Reserve Fund and Endowment Fund/ No Objection Certificate (NOC) for encashment of FDRs will be issued by the Regional Director on the submission of the following: -

- (a) NOC from the affiliating body.
- (b) NOC from the staff/faculty.
- (c) Resolution of the management to the effect for closure of the course."

NOW THEREFORE, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to **Sri Venkateswara College of Education, Srinivasa Educational Academy, R.V.S. Nagar, Tirupati Road, Muthirevulu, Chittoor-517127, Andhra Pradesh** run by **Srinivasa Educational Academy, R.V.S. Nagar, Muthirevulu Post, Chittoor, Andhra Pradesh-517127** for conducting **M.Ed. course** of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (one unit) with effect from the next academic session i.e., 2021-2022 onwards.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."
