WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition u/s 14 of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, **Maheshwara College of Education, Mahabubabad Revenue Division Maheshwaran Village, Narsampet Mandal, Warangal District, Andhra Pradesh-506331** vide order no. F.AP/NEW/B.Ed./294/SRO/NCTE/2002-2003/7735 dt. 23.06.2003 for conducting B.Ed. course with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2002-2003.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit for its willingness of two units in B.Ed. course and adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 31.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 381st Meeting held on 31st October & 01st November, 2019 decided to issue SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted the requisite documents/VT report accompanied with the requisite documents. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC a First Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 05.11.2019. The institution has submitted reply on 03.01.2020.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 405th Meeting held on 13th & 14th December 2021 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 27.12.2021. The institution has submitted reply on 12.01.2022.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 408th Meeting held on 02nd March, 2022 considered the matter and decided as under: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN). The institution has submitted its reply on 12.01.2022. The Committee observed the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies.

1. *The institute submitted a proforma of 7 Faculty signed by the Registrar, Kakatiya University. The faculty strength is not enough to run B.Ed. course with one unit (as requested in its letter dt. 12.01.2022) as per appendix of NCTE Regulations, 2014. The institution also failed to submit supporting documents in terms of educational qualification of the faculty and experience certificate of the Principal.*



2. Faculty namely P. Suresh Kumar, ShyamuDudimatla, Devender Togaru are not NET qualified and appointed after 09.06.2017, hence not eligible for appointment as per NCTE Regulations (amended vide notification dt. 09.06.2017).
3. The institute submitted a proforma of 8 faculty for D.El.Ed. course signed by the Director, SCERT, Telangana on 16.10.2019. The institute failed in submission of latest approval of faculty issued by the SCERT.
4. The institute did not submit form 'A' and FDRs for Endowment and Reserve Funds for D.El.Ed. course.
5. As per building plan the size of multipurpose hall is less than the requirement of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
6. The building plan submitted by the institute is neither approved nor legible.
7. As per Sale Deed dt. 11.09.2000 some portion of the building is roofed by AC sheets which is not permissible under clause 8 (7) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
8. The website of the institution is not uploaded with the information required under clauses 7(14)(i), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
9. Society Registration Certificate, Bye Laws etc., not submitted by the institution.
10. The institute failed in submission of the bank statement of all individual faculty and institution's bank statement duly certified by the concerned bank showing disbursement of salary through bank Account to faculty as required under clause 10 (3) of NCTE Regulation, 2014.

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Maheshwara Collage of Education, Mahabubabad Division, Maheshwaran Village, Narasampet Mandal, Warangal District-, Telangana** for conducting **B.Ed. & D.Ed.** programme with effect from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."

6. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Maheshwara Collage of Education, Mahabubabad Division, Maheshwaran Village, Narasampet Mandal, Warangal District-, Telangana-506132** run by **Maheshwara Educational Society, Mahabubabad Division, Maheshwaran Village, Narasampet Mandal, Warangal District-, Telangana-506132** for conducting **B.Ed. programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (2 basic units) with effect from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023 onwards.

7. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

8. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
