ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **R.K.L.K College of Education, Suryapet, Nalgonda District-508213, Telangana** run by **Nalanda Educational Society, Suryapet, Nalgonda Dt. Telangana** vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.AP/B.Ed/SRO/NCTE/2004-2005/817 dt. 24.02.2005 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dt 22.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 12.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution submitted another representation on 29.02.2016 and 03.03.2016. The SRC in its 314th meeting held on 27th to 28th May 2016. The Committee considered the matter and decided to constitute the VT of the institution. Accordingly, the inspection intimation was sent to the institution on 14.06.2016. The inspection was conducted on 15.10.2016 and the VT report received on 18.10.2016 along with documents and CD. The SRC in its 323rd meeting held on 16-18 November 2016, considered the matter and decided to issue SCN to the institution. As per decision of SRC a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 29/11/2016. Before issuance of Show cause notice, as per website information the institution submitted its reply along with relevant document on 19.12.2016.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 348th meeting held on 05th& 06thDecember, 2017 again considered the matter and decided to issue SCN to the institution. Accordingly a show cause notice was issued on 12.12.2017. The institution submitted its reply on 02.01.2018. The SRC in its 361st meeting held on 21st – 22nd June, 2018 considered the matter decided as under:-

1. They have completed all formalities.
2. Issue a fresh FR for B.Ed (2 units) under the 2014 Regulations.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, as per the decision of the SRC taken in its 381st meeting held on 31st& 01st Nov, 2019 a Final show cause notice was issued to the institution on 19.11.2019 asking the institution to submit requisite documents regarding land & building etc. of the institution. The institution vide letter dated 06.01.2020 submitted its reply to the Final show cause notice.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered in 383rd Meeting of SRC held on 7th – 9th January, 2020 and decided to issue Final SCN against on the following points:-

1. It is observed the Management of the institution is running host of course in same campus which include school, Jr. College, Pharmacy etc. The institution is required to submit a certificate from the Regional Joint Director, School Education regarding facilities created for B.Ed & D.El.Ed programmes.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, as per the decision of SRC a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 20.01.2020. The SRC office is in receipt of a letter from the Asst. Director, Regional Joint Director of School Education, Hyderabad vide letter No. 366/B4/2020 dated 19.02.2020, has sent a letter and stating as under:-

“.....in response to the letter under reference 1st cited and as per the inspection report submitted by the District Educational Officer, Suryapet vide reference 4th cited. I am to clarify that, there is no other educational institutions like school or junior college is established in the premises R.K.L.K. College of Education, Suryapet as on today.

This is submitted for kind information and further necessary action in this matter.”

8. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter of the institution was finally considered by the SRC in its 385th meeting held on 03rd March, 2020 and decided as under:-

The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

On the perusal of the original documents and records submitted by the institution. The Committee decided that the **continuation order be issued to R.K.L.K College of Education, Nalgonda District-508213, Telangana for B.Ed programme for 2 basic units (50 students each).**

9. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e. **R.K.L.K College of Education, H.No. 1-2/360/1, Sy.No. 755, Ward No. 28, Suryapet-508213 Nalgonda District, Telangana** run by **Nalanda Educational Society, Suryapet-508213, Nalgonda District, Telangana** for continuation of recognition for B.Ed course of two years duration with an intake of **(two units)** of 50 students each subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
 - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
10. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc as applicable.
11. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
12. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-
- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution;
 - b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
 - c. Name of faculty members who left of joined during the last, quarter;
 - d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
 - e. Fee charged from students;
 - f. Available infrastructural facilities;
 - g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
 - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
 - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
 - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
 - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
13. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
14. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
15. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.
