WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely Vidyalaya College of Education, SBI Colony Renigunta Road Akkaram Pali, Tirupathi Chittor district-517507 Andhra Pradesh run by Shirdi Sai Educational Society, 4/68, Tiruchuttu Street, Vayalpad, Chittor District, Andhra Pradesh vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.AP/NEW/B.Ed/88/SRO/NCTE/2002-2003/6717 dt 04.04.2003 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 197th meeting held on 13th-14th October 2010 considered the matter and decided to permit shifting of the institution accordingly, a letter dated 03.12.2010 was issued to the institution

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dated 19.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 06.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (Two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 314th meeting held during 27th & 38th May 2016 considered the reply of the revised order and decided to constitute inspection, as per the decision of SRC a inspection letter was issued to the institution on 14.06.2016. On 06.07.2016 a letter is received by this office from the institution.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 318th meeting held on 8th-9th August 2016 considered the matter and decided to according to earlier VT inspection report, built-up area is adequate. Therefore, another inspection is not required and they have given a Faculty list that is approved by competent authority. But they have not given the original faculty list.

AND WHEREAS, as per the decision 369th Meeting of SRC held on 28.01.2019 a Show Cause Notice to be issue to all such institution which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 13.05.2019. The institution has not submit the show cause notice reply till date.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in 381th meeting held on 31st Oct & 1st Nov, 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted the following requisite documents/VT Repost accompanied with requisite documents in respond to RPRO issued by the SRC. Further, the RD is authorized to issue Final Show Cause Notice and then place the cases before the SRC for its perusal and decision. Accordingly, Final Show Cause was issued on 06.12.2019. The institution submitted its reply on 31.01.2020

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 388th Meeting held on 14th & 15th September, 2020 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The Committee noticed that the institutions which were granted recognition on Rented Premises with a condition to shift its building to new permanent building. And, the institutions which have not yet shifted to its own permanent building.

1. The institution has not shifted its institution to own permanent building which is a violation of the NCTE Regulations 2002, 3(c).

In view of the above, the Committee also perused the reply submitted by the institution on 31.01.2020. And the Committee found the following deficiencies: -

- 1. The institution has not submitted certified copy of registered land documents.
- 2. Built-up area, site area and multipurpose hall area is not readable in the building plan submitted by the institution.
- 3. Site plan is not approved by the competent authority and built-up area is not mentioned in the site plan.
- 4. The institution has not submitted Form 'A' issued by the Branch Manager. The institution is required to submit Form "A" issued by the bank manager towards creation of FDR of Rs. 7 lakh & Rs. 5 lakhs towards Endowment Fund & Reserve Fund.

Hence, the Committee decided to Withdraw the recognition granted to Vidyalaya College of Education, Chittor District, Andhra Pradesh for conducting B.Ed. course w.e.f. the 2020-21 academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of Vidyalaya College of Education, 4/32, SBI Colony Renigunta Road Akkaram Pali, Tirupathi Chittor district-517507 Andhra Pradesh for conducting B.Ed. programme of two year duration with an annual intake of 100 students (2 units) w.e.f. the next academic session.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
