WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

AND WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, Farook B.Ed. College, Chenguvetty, Kottakkal, Parappur P.O. Malappuram District, Pin-676503, Kerala run by Farook Educational Society, Chenguvetty, Kottakkal, Parappur P.O. Malappuram District, Pin-676503, Kerala vide SRC (NCTE) order No. F.KL/SEC/N/170/SRO/NCTE/2004-2005/754 dated 23.02.2005 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2004-2005.

2. AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted an affidavit dated 28.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

3. AND WHEREAS, a Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 15.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (one basic unit) from the academic session 2015-2016.

4. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 21.02.2019. In response, the institution submitted its written representation on 27.03.2019.

5. AND WHEREAS, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 383rd Meeting held on January 07-09, 2020 and the Committee decided as follows:-

The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Institution was issued a Show Cause Notice (SCN) on 21.02.2019. The institution has not submitted any reply / written representation against the Show Cause Notice issued. Hence, the Committee decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice for B.Ed course to the institution to submit the following documents :-

1. B/P is approved by Assistant Executive Engineer, LSGD Submission not mentioned Sy no etc.
2. EC submitted in Regional Language. English version/ translation not submitted.

3. Photocopy of Staff list submitted but not approved by the affiliating body.
4. Approved land document not submitted.
5. FDRs is submitted (Original)-Term of one FDR amounting to Rs 5,31,121/- is over on 28/08/2019.

Therefore, the Committee decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 before withdrawal of the recognition on the grounds mentioned above to the institution. The institution is required to submit the documents within 21 days from the date of issue of Final Show Cause Notice.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, as per decision taken in the meeting 383rd, a Final Show Cause was issued to the institution on 20.01.2020. In response, the institution submitted its reply on 10.02.2020.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 388th meeting held on September 14-15, 2020 and the Committee decided as follows; -

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines Issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution on 10.02.2020. The Committee observed and found the following deficiencies; -

1. The institution has submitted JENM Deed which is in the name of individual and the same is not permissible under NCTE Regulations.
2. The institution has not submitted notarized English version of latest Encumbrance Certificate duly approved by the competent authority.
3. Other documents like NEC, LUC, Building Plan etc. are not acceptable on the face of deficiency in land documents.
4. The Staff list submitted by the institution is not adequate as per NCTE Regulations, 2014 (amended vide notification dt. 09.06.2017). The institution has not appointed faculty for Fine Arts & Performing Arts. 4 Faculties do not have NET/Ph.D since their appointment date was after 09.07.2017.
5. The institution has not submitted Form 'A' towards Endowment and Reserve Fund as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Farook B.Ed. College, Chenguvetty, Kottakkal, Parappur P.O. Malappuram District, Pin-676503, Kerala for conducting B.Ed. course w.e.f. the 2020-21 academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

8. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to Farook

B.Ed. College, Chenguvetty, Kottakkal, Parappur P.O. Malappuram District, Pin-676503, Kerala for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students w.e.f. the next academic session.

9. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

10. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
