WITHDRAWAL ORDER

24 SEP 2020

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **Sri Balaji Institute of Education and Training, Plot No. 206, 144, DMM Road, Mylepalli, Ananthapur – 515144, Andhra Pradesh** run by **Sri Balaji Education Society, Plot No. 1/393, Dharmavaram Road, Kothcheruva Village & Post, Puttaparthi, Ananthpur-515133, Andhra Pradesh** vide SRC (NCTE) order No. F.SRO/SRCAPP590/D.El.Ed/AP/2015/77426 dated 05.11.2015 for conducting **D.El.Ed course** of two-year duration with an annual intake of 50 students.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 295th Meeting held on 28th & 30th November & 1st December, 2015 considered the matter and decided to the decision taken in the 291st meeting is reviewed. Reference to fulfilment of all norms/standards by 31-Oct 2015 was w.r.t B.Ed. There is no such requirement of D.El.Ed. This conditionality is, therefore, removed from the decision taken earlier.

AND WHEREAS, a letter No. RC.No. 359/A/SCERT/2019 dated 29.6.2020 is received from the Commissioner, School Education (FAC), School Education Department, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh on 17.07.2020 recommending therein for derecognition order in respect of 188 Pvt. D.El.Ed. Colleges in A.P. since the said managements of Pvt. D.El.Ed. Colleges have made admission into the D.El.Ed. Course during academic year 2018-19 on their own in violation of Government orders.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by SRC in its 386th meeting held on 23rd-24th July, 2020 and decided to issue SCN. As per the decision of SRC a Show Cause Notice issued to the institution on 30.07.2020. The institution vide letter dated 10.08.2020 & 31.08.2020 submitted written representation.

AND WHEREAS, the institution vide letter dated 24.08.2020 submitted written representation. The SRC in its 388th meeting held during 14th – 15th September, 2020 considered the matter and decided as under;

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Sri Balaji Institute of Education and Training, Plot No. 206, 144, DMM Road, Mylepalli, Ananthapur – 515144, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting **D.El.Ed course** under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 **on its own request** made vide letter dated 10.08.2020 & 31.08.2020. However, the FDRs towards Reserve Fund and Endowment Fund/ No Objection Certificate (NOC) for encashment of FDRs will be issued by the Regional Director on the submission of the following:

- a. NOC from the affiliating body.
- b. NOC from the staff/faculty.
- c. Resolution of the management to the effect for closure of the course

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of **Sri Balaji Institute of Education and Training, Plot No. 206, 144, DMM Road, Mylepalli, Ananthapur – 515144, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting D.El.Ed programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (1 units) from the next academic session starts after issuance of this order.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
