WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, **Sai Sharada D.Ed. College, B.M. Road, Opp. Rotary Adichunchanagiri Hospital, Ramangaram-571511, Bangalore Rural District, Karnataka** run by **Sri Sharada Educational Trust, Ramangaram, Bangalore Rural District, Karnataka** vide SRC vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/D.Ed/2004-2005/8727 dt. 29.11.2004 for Elementary (D.Ed.) course of two and half years duration from the academic session 2004-05 with an annual intake of 50 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has submitted written representation on 11.10.2021 for request for permission for closing of their institution as under: -

“With reference to the above, we would submit that there is no admission for the D.El.Ed. course. The course is not being offered from the academic session 2014-2015. Hence we submit herewith a request to closure of D.El.Ed course and submitting the following documents for kind consideration.

1. *Resolution of the Management of Original to close the D.Ed. College.*
2. *Application in the prescribed format for closure of Teacher Education programme.*
3. *Order of the Government of Karnataka permitting for closure of D.Ed. course.*
4. *Permission Order from the Affiliating Authority i.e., Department of State Educational Research and Training, Bangalore to close the D.Ed. College.*
5. *No Objection Certificate from the staff members.*
6. *Copies of FDRs in Joint Account with SRC with a request to permit to withdraw the amount.*

We from the Management Shri Sharada Educational Trust, Ramangaram request SRC, NCTE to kindly withdraw the recognition of D.Ed. course and also accord permission to withdraw the FDRs.”

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 403<sup>rd</sup> Meeting held on 18<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup> October, 2021 considered the FSCN reply matter and decided as under: -

“The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The Committee agreed to close down the institution as requested by the institution on 11.10.2021 by withdrawing the recognition granted to **Sai Sharada D.Ed. College, B.M. Road, Opp. Rotary Adichunchanagiri Hospital, Ramangaram-571511, Bangalore Rural District, Karnataka** for conducting **D.Ed. Programme** under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic session 2021-2022.

However, the FDRs towards Reserve Fund and Endowment Fund/ No Objection Certificate (NOC) for encashment of FDRs will be issued by the Regional Director as per the general resolution taken by the SRC in this meeting."

4. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Sai Sharada D.Ed. College, B.M. Road, Opp. Rotary Adichunchanagiri Hospital, Ramangaram-571511, Bangalore Rural District, Karnataka** run by **Sri Sharada Educational Trust, Ramangaram, Bangalore Rural District, Karnataka** for conducting **D.Ed. programme** of two and half years duration with an annual intake of **50 students (1 basic units)** with effect from the academic session i.e., 2021-2022 onwards.

5. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

***"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."***

6. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website [www.ncte-india.org](http://www.ncte-india.org) within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
