WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely Amerda Vikas College of Education, No.5/118-120, Gajalnaickenpatty Post, Dasanaichenpatty (Via), Salem District, Tamilnadu run Sree Educational and Charitable Trust, Salem-636016, Tamilnadu vide SRC order No.F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2006-2007/12531 dt. 04.10.2007 for conducting Secondary (B.Ed.) course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. AND WHEREAS, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution by consented to come under new Regulations vide a notarized affidavit dated 24.01.2015. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 18.03.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (Two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 has considered the matter and the Committee decided to issue a Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 29.07.2019. The institution vide letter dated 26.08.2019 has submitted in response to the Show Cause Notice.

4. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 381st meeting held on 31st oct – 01st Nov 2019 has considered the matter and the Committee decided to issue a Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 06.11.2019. The institution vide letter dated 29.11.2019 has submitted a reply in response to the Final Show Cause Notice.

5. AND WHEREAS, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 395th meeting held on February 25-26, 2021 and the Committee decided as follows: -

The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Committee considered the reply submitted by the institution on 29.11.2019 in response to the Final Show Cause Notice. The Committee found the following deficiency: -

1. The institution has not submitted a certified copy of Land Documents. Sale deed is in the favour of Individual Person. Thus the same is not as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014.

2. The institution has submitted a notarized Building Stability Certificate as BUILDING COMPLETION CERTIFICATE which is not in the Prescribed format of NCTE.
3. The institution is required to submit latest Faculty List. Out of 16, three Lecturers does not have NET/Ph.D. as per NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) (Amendment) Regulations, 2017 dated 29.05.2017 notified on 09.06.2017.
4. The institution is required to submit an Affidavit clearly stating status about land & building and Management at the time of recognition.
5. The institution has submitted Lease Deed as land document at the time of recognition and now submitted land document in the form of Sale Deed which is in the name of individual person.

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to the institution namely, **Amerda Vikas College of Education, No.5/118-120, Gajalnaickenpatty Post, Dasanaichenpatty (Via), Salem District, Tamilnadu** for conducting B.Ed course with effect from the next academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

6. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Amerda Vikas College of Education, No.5/118-120, Gajalnaickenpatty Post, Dasanaichenpatty (Via), Salem District, Tamilnadu** run by **Sree Educational and Charitable Trust, Salem-636016, Tamilnadu** for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (2 units) w.e.f. the next academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards.

7. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

8. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website

www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
