WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to **Adarsh Vidhyalaya College of Education, Adarsh Nagar, Bhavani Taluk, Erode-638312, Tamilnadu** the SRC vide order No. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2006-2007/13126 dated 18.10.2007 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year duration from the academic session 2006-2007 with an annual intake of 100 students.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dt. 02.03.2015 for its willingness of **2 Units in B.Ed. course of 100 students** and adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 25.05.2015 for conducting **B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2015-16.**

AND WHEREAS, a letter received from the institution on 19.12.2016 requesting to sanction one basic unit of 50 students for B.Ed. course. A corrigendum No. SRO/NCTE/APS07758/B.Ed/TN/2017-18/95171 dated 04.10.2017 was issued to the institution for conducting B.Ed. programme of two year duration with an **annual intake of 50 for one basic unit of 50 students.**

AND WHEREAS, the matter was finally considered the SRC in its 395th meeting held on 25th - 26th February, 2021 considered the matter and decided as under: -

"The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

1. The Committee noted that due to non-compliance of SCN dated 24.07.2019 for submission of requisite documents to verify infrastructure & instructional facilities a Final Show Cause Notice dated 10.08.2020 was issued to the institution. However the institution failed to submit the requisite documents as per Final Show Notice dated 10.08.2020.
2. Further the SRC also given the last opportunity for submission of written representation/reply by way of last Reminder letter dated 21.09.2020 and the institution failed to submit the reply to the last reminder letter.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Adharsh Vidhyalaya College of Education, Adharsh Nagar, Bhavani Taluk, Erode – 638312, Tamil Nadu for conducting B.Ed. course with effect from the next academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.”

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Adarsh Vidhyalaya College of Education, Adarsh Nagar, Bhavani Taluk, Erode-638312, Tamilnadu** run by **Kalvithantai A K R Sourashtra Teachers College, Sayanapuram, Panniyar Post, Madurai-625009, Tamilnadu** for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of one basic unit of 50 students w.e.f the next academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website www.ncte-india.org, with 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filling appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
