WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **Sri B.V.N. College of Physical Education, 4th Cross, Robertsonpet, K.G.F-563122, Kolar District, Karnataka** vide SRC (NCTE) order No. F.SRO/NCTE/B.P.Ed /2005-2006/508 dated 20.04.2005 for (B.P.Ed.) course of one-year duration from the academic session 2005-2006 with an annual intake of 50 students.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dated 14.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, a revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 20.05.2015 for conducting B.P.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of one basic units of 100 students from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, Show Cause Notice issued on 16.05.2019. The institution has not submitted any reply in respect of Show Cause Notice.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 388th meeting held on 14th-15th September 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue Final SCN to all the institutions wherein Recognition was accorded by the SRC with the direction to submit all requisite documents. Accordingly, a Final Show Cause was issued on 13.10.2020. The institution has submitted along with documents on 18.11.2020:

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 395th Meeting held on 25th – 26th February 2021 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The Committee considered the reply submitted by the institution on 01.02.2021 in respect to the Final Show Cause Notice and found the following deficiencies: -

The Committee considered the reply submitted by the institution on 18.11.2020 in response to the Final Show Cause Notice. The Committee found the following deficiency: -

1. The building plan submitted by the institution is not legible.
2. BUILDING COMPLETION CERTIFICATE submitted by the institute is not in prescribed format.
3. The institution has submitted Non-Encumbrance Certificate in regional language. Notarized translation not submitted by the institution.
4. The size of Multipurpose Hall is not clear on Building Plan.
5. The institute did not submit LAND USE CERTIFICATE issued by the competent authority.
6. Two associate professors as required under NCTE Regulations, 2014 (Appendix -7) have not been appointed by the institution.
7. The institute submitted a letter dt. 24.12.2019 issued by the Registrar, Bengaluru University regarding approval of the 1 Principal and 10 Lecturers but 9 Lecturers are approved with a final condition to clear NET / SLET within one year from the date of approval. No further relaxation or extension in this regard.
8. Three part time sports trainers, 1 (part time) Yoga Trainer and 1 Dietician (part time) have not been appointed.
9. Multipurpose Play field for outdoor sports, 400 Mtr athletic track, Gymnasium, Hall for indoor games and sports have not been provided as required under Appendix 7 of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
10. Anatomy, Physiology and Health Education Laboratory, Human performance Laboratory, Physiotherapy, Athletic care and rehabilitation laboratory sports psychology laboratory etc as required under Appendix – 7 of NCTE Regulations, 2014 have not been provided.
11. Fire Safety certificate has not been submitted.
12. The institution not submitted Details of Total Land & Built-up area for the Recognized Teacher Education Programme.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to the institution namely, **B.V.N. College of Physical Education, 4th Cross, Robertsonpet, K.G.F, Kolar District, Karnataka** for conducting B.P.Ed course with effect from the next academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of **Sri B.V.N. College of Physical Education, 4th Cross, Robertsonpet, K.G.F-563122, Kolar District, Karnataka** for conducting B.P.Ed. programme of two year duration with an annual intake of 100 students (1 unit) for B.P.Ed. course with effect from the next academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such

course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
