ORDER

WHEREAS, the institution namely **Vidyaa Vikas College of Education, S.No.93PT, 94/1B, Varahoorampatti Village, Tiruchengode, Namakkal District – 637214, Tamilnadu** was granted recognition vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/M.Ed./2006-2007/15955 dt. 17.12.2007 for conducting **M.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 25 students** from the academic session 2006-2007. The intake of **M.Ed. course** was enhanced on the basis of NCTE (amendment) Regulations, 2010 from 25 to 35.

AND WHEREAS, the Tamilnadu Teachers Education University had forwarded a copy of show cause notice issued to the institution for not functioning in accordance with the conditions stipulated by the NCTE, SRC, Bangalore and Tamilnadu Teachers Education University as could be apprehended from the report of Inspection commission which caused a surprise visit to the colleges.

AND WHEREAS, after the promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014 and as per affidavits affidavit submitted by the institution on dt. 24.01.2015 and the provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on dt. 22.05.2015 for M.Ed. course for conducting two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (one unit) from the academic session 2015-2016.

AND WHEREAS, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. As per the decision a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 19.07.2019 in M.Ed.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 388th meeting passed a common decision to send the Show Cause Notice to the institutions where RPRO compliance was not submitted. A Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution for B.Ed and M.Ed on 25.09.2020. The institution has submitted its reply on 28.09.2020.

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AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 389th meeting held on 12th & 14th October, 2020 considered and decided as the following grounds:

“The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution vide letter dt 28.09.2020, the Committee decided that the **continuation order** be issued to the Institution **Vidyaa vikas College of Education, Varahoorampatti, Tiruchengode – 637214, Tamilnadu** for the following courses:-

- (i) ***B.Ed - 4 units (50 students each unit).***
- (ii) ***M.Ed- 1 unit of 50 students.”***

NOW THEREFORE, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e. **Vidyaa Vikas College of Education, S.No.93PT, 94/1B, Varahoorampatti Village, Tiruchengode, Namakkal District – 637214, Tamilnadu** for continuation of recognition for M.Ed. programme for 1 unit of 50 students subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
 - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
 - III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
 - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
1. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, the State Government etc as applicable.
 2. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

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3. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
 - b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
 - c. Name of faculty members who left of joined during the last, quarter:
 - d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
 - e. Fee charged from students;
 - f. Available infrastructural facilities;
 - g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
 - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
 - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
 - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
 - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
4. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
5. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
6. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

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Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.
