**CONTINUATION ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, the recognition u/s 14(3)(a) of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely **Bangalore City College of Education, # 115, Vijaya Bank Colony, Ring Road, Near perrol Bunk, Doddabanasawadi, Bangalore-560043, Karnataka** run by **Ramakrishna Education Trust, Bangalore-560043, Karnataka** vide order No. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2005-2006/5043 dated 30.12.2005 for conducting **B.Ed. Course** of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2005-2006.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution by consented to come under new Regulations vide a notarized affidavit dated 14.01.2015 and the Revised Provisional Recognition Order(RPRO) was issued to the institution on 16.05.2015 for conducting **B.Ed. Programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students for two basic units of 50 students each from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 381<sup>st</sup> Meeting held on 31<sup>st</sup> October & 01<sup>st</sup> November, 2019 decided to issue SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted the requisite documents/VT report accompanied with the requisite documents. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 07.09.2020.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 388<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup> September 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN/FSCN in all RPRO cases asking them to submit all the required documents as per the 13 points. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 09.10.2020. The institution has submitted its reply received on 03.10.2021.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 414<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> September 2022 considered the matter Committee decided to withdraw the recognition. Accordingly as per the decision of SRC a withdrawal order No. F.SRC/NCTE/APS02368/B.Ed./KA/2022/137604-137608 was issued to the institution on 01.12.2022.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, aggrieved by the order of the SRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order No. 89-35/E-289626/2023 Appeal/3<sup>rd</sup> Meeting, 2023 APPLSRC2023145525 dated 07.03.2023 appeal remand back the order appealed against. The institution has submitted reply of appeal remand back case vide letter dated 07.04.2023.

9. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 423<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> April 2023 considered the matter and decided as under:-

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***“The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -***

***The Committee on the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution Bangalore City College of Education, Survey No. 160, Chelekere Main Road, Kalyan Nagar Post, Bangalore-560043, Karnataka for B.Ed. programme for 2 basic units of 50 students each”.***

**10. NOW THEREFORE,** this order is issued permitting the institution i.e. **Bangalore City College of Education, Survey No. 160, Chelekere Main Road, Kalyan Nagar Post, Bangalore-560043, Karnataka** run by **Ramakrishna Education Trust, Bangalore-560043, Karnataka** for continuation of recognition for **B.Ed. Programme** for two-years duration with an annual intake of **2 basic unit of 100 students** subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:-


- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

**11.** Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.

**12.** The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

**13.** The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
- b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c. Name of faculty members who left of joined during the last, quarter:



- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
- e. Fee charged from students;
- f. Available infrastructural facilities;
- g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information if it so desires.
- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

14. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.

15. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.


16. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
