WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, Stella Matutina College of Education, Kamaraj Salai, Ashok Nagar, Chennai – 600083, Tamilnadu for M.Ed. programme as per following details:-

- (i) The SRC vide Order No F.TN/M.Ed/22/SRO/NCTE/2000-2001/688 dt. 04.07.2000 for M.Ed course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 10 (Ten only) students from the academic sessions 2000-2001.
- (ii) The SRC vide order No. F/TN/M.ED/NCTE/SRO/NCTE/2003-04/4706 dated 06.07.2004 for **M.Ed.(additional intake)** programme of one year duration with an annual intake of 25 students including existing intake of 10 students and an additional intake of 15 students from the academic session 2004-2005.
- 2. AND WHEREAS, the enhancement of intake of 10 seats from existing 25 to 35 was permitted to Stella Matutina College of Education, Kamaraj Salai, Ashok Nagar, Chennai 600083, Tamilnadu vide order No. F.SRO/NCTE/2010-2011/20948 dated 03.09.2010 from the session 2010-2011.
- 3. AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted an affidavit dated 27.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A Revised Provisional Recognition Order (RPRO) was issued to the institution on 25.05.2015 for conducting M.Ed. Programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (one basic unit) from the academic session 2015-2016.
- 4. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 has considered the matter and decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 03.05.2019. The institution did not submit reply to Show Cause Notice.
- 5. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 376th meeting held on 11th 12th June, 2019 has considered the matter and decided to issue Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 20.06.2019. The institution has submitted its reply vide letter dated 11.07.2019. The institution has submitted vide letter dated 11.06.2024 request for continuation both courses B.Ed. & M.Ed. programme.
- 6. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 439th meeting held on 14th June, 2024 has considered the matter and decided as under:-

> The Committee on the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, it is decided that the continuation order be issued to the institution Stella Matutina College of Education, Survey No. 70 part, 71 part, 76 part, 77 part, Kodambakkam Village, Mambalam Guindy Taluk (Now Mambalam Taluk), Ashok Nagar, Chennai - 600083, Tamil Nadu for M.Ed., programme for 1 basic unit of 50 students."

- NOW THEREFORE, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e., Stella Matutina College of Education, Survey No. 70 part, 71 part, 76 part, 77 part, Kodambakkam Village, Mambalam Guindy Taluk (Now Mambalam Taluk), Ashok Nagar, Chennai - 600083, Tamil Nadu for Continuation of recognition for M.Ed. programme for two years duration with an annual intake of 1 basic unit of 50 students subject to fulfilment of the following conditions: -
 - The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
 - The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
 - The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining III. body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
 - The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
- Further, the institution is required to fulfil all such other requirements as may be 8. prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.
