WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, **B.G.S College of Education, Sri Adichunchanagiri Kshetra, Nagamanagala Taluk, Mandya District, Karnataka-571811** run by **Sri Adichunchanagiri Shikshana Trust, Mandya District, Karnataka** vide SRC vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2006-2007/14492 dt. 12.11.2007 for Secondary (B.Ed.) course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dated 19.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 16.05.2015 for conducting **B.Ed. programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **100 students** for **two basic units** from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 348th meeting held on 05th – 06th December, 2017 considered the VT report matter and decided to issue Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 12.12.2017. The institution has submitted reply on 27.12.2017.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 381st meeting held on 31st Oct & 01st Nov, 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted the following requisite documents/VT report not accompanied with the requisite documents. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 07.09.2020. The institution has submitted reply on 21.09.2021.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 394th meeting held on 27th – 28th January, 2021 considered the matter and decided to issue last reminder letter. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a last reminder letter was issued to the institution on 05.02.2021. The institution has submitted reply on 15.02.2021.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 396th meeting held on 03rd March 2021 considered the matter and decided to issue a letter. Again, as per the decision of SRC a letter was issued to the institution on 10.03.2021. The institution has submitted reply on 24.03.2021.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 402nd Meeting held on 13th & 14th September, 2021 considered the a letter matter and decided as under: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The institution was issued a Last Reminder Letter. The institution has submitted its reply vide letter dated 24.03.2021. The Committee observed the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies.

1. **Vide Final reminder dt. 10.03.2021 the institution was informed that faculty in respect of Fine Arts, Performing Arts and Physical Education are the part timer lecturers which is not permissible under NCTE Regulations, 2014. Now alongwith the reply submitted by the institution vide letter dt. 24.03.2021 the institution submitted a photocopy of proforma of 3 faculty appointed for said courses but the same has not been certified by any of the authority of the Institution also the same do not contain date of approval of the affiliating body.**
2. **These three faculties are shown to be appointed on 12.09.2020 and 08.03.2021 but was not included in the proforma of faculty submitted by the institution vide its letter dt. 15.03.2021.**
3. **These three faculties are appointed on a salary of Rs 17,000/- and 21, 000/- p.m. whereas the clause 5.4 of Appendix 4 of NCTE Regulations, 2014 stipulates that "the terms and conditions of service of teaching and non-teaching staff including selection procedure, pay scales, age of superannuation and other benefits shall be as per policy of the State Government / Affiliating body.'**
4. **The institution did not submit any proof regarding disbursement of salary of faculty and other staff through bank account as required under.**
5. **Website of the institution is not functional with upload the information required under clause 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.**

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to B.G.S. College of Education, Sri Adichunchanagiri Ksheta – 571811, Nagamangala Taluk, Mandya District, Karnataka for conducting B.Ed. programme with effect from the academic session i.e., 2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."

7. NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to B.G.S. College of Education, Sri Adichunchanagiri Ksheta – 571811, Nagamangala Taluk, Mandya District, Karnataka run by Sri Adichunchanagiri Shikshana Trust, Mandya District, Karnataka for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of (2 basic units) for 50 students each with effect from the academic session i.e., 2021-2022 onwards.

8. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

9. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
