WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, **B.T.L. College of Education, No. 259/B, Bommasandra Industrial Area, Hosur Main Road, Bangalore** run by **B.T.L. Educational Trust for Rural Development, Bangalore, Karnataka** vide SRC vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2005-2006/5262 dt. 30.01.2006 for Secondary (B.Ed.) course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2005-2006.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dated 06.05.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 31.05.2015 for conducting **B.Ed. programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **100 students for two basic units** from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 290th Meeting held on 10th & 11th July, 2015 considered the matter and decided to issue Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 15.09.2015. The institution has submitted reply on 15.10.2015.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 381st meeting held on 31st Oct & 01st Nov, 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted the following requisite documents/VT report not accompanied with the requisite documents. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 07.09.2020. The institution has submitted reply on 30.09.2020.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 402nd Meeting held on 13th & 14th September, 2021 considered the FSCN reply matter and decided as under: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN). The institution has submitted its reply vide letter dated 30.09.2020. The Committee observed the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies.

1. *The initial recognition was granted to the institution on the land at Survey no. 259/B, measuring 28,335 sq.mts in Bommasandra, Industrial Area Attibele, Hobli whereas the institution has with the reply submitted vide letter dt. 30.03.2020 submitted a copy of letter dt. 21.07.2000 issued by the Karnataka Industrial Areas Development Board regarding handing over the possession of land at S.Nos. 13/1,2,3,4, 14/1, 2,3,19,20 and 21/1 measuring 5.26 acres. Change in location observed which is*

not permissible under clause 8(9) of NCTE Regulations, 2014. The institution is required to clarify the same and if it is, so the institution is required to submit the application for shifting of premise as required under clause 8 (9) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.

2. The institution submitted building plan but the same is not only 92.67 sq.mts (997.49 sq. ft) which is the violation of requirement laid down under clause 6(ii)(b) of Appendix 4 of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
3. The institution submitted copy of letters dt. 23.05.2018 (appointment of Principal), 10.04.2018 (appointment of Principal and 5 faculty and 16.01.2020 are subject to condition to clear NET / SLET within two years and obtain a PG degree in disciplinary subject which is not permissible under Appendix 4 of NCTE Regulations, 2014. Further, the proforma of faculty duly approved by the affiliating body have not been submitted. Faculty strengths are also not enough as stipulated under clause 5.1 of appendix 4 of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
4. The institution has submitted Possession Certificate which is not legible.
5. The institution did not submit Non- Encumbrance Certificate.
6. The institution has submitted BCC but required to prescribe format as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.
7. The institution has submitted Original FDRs of Endowment and Reserve Funds of Rs 5 lakhs & 3 lakhs are matured.
8. Website of the institution is not functional with upload the information required under clause 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **B.T.L. College of Education, No. 259/B, Bommasandra Industrial Area, Hosur Main Road, Bangalore – 560099, Karnataka** for conducting B.Ed. programme with effect from the academic session i.e., 2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."

6. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **B.T.L. College of Education, No. 259/B, Bommasandra Industrial Area, Hosur Main Road, Bangalore – 560099, Karnataka** run by **B.T.L Educational Trust for Rural Development, No. 259/B, Bommasandra Industrial Area, Hosur Road, Bangalore, Karnataka-560099** for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of **100 students (2 basic units)** with effect from the academic session i.e., 2021-2022 onwards.

7. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

8. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
