**CONTINUATION ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, **Blessy College of Education, Navalingam Nagar, Chidambaram Taluk, Cuddalore District-608001, Tamilnadu** vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2006-2007/18830 dated 17.03.2008 for **Secondary (B.Ed.)** course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dated 22.01.2015 & for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 30.04.2015 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, as per the decision a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 05.09.2019. The institution has not submitted any reply in response to the Show Cause Notice.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was further considered by the Sub-committee constituted by the SRC as per in its 380 meeting decision, the sub-committee decided to issue a Final Show Cause to all such institution where reply to Show Cause Notice has not been submitted by the institution. Accordingly, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 24.10.2019. The institution vide letter dated 28.10.2019 has submitted a reply in response to the Show Cause Notice

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 384<sup>th</sup> Meeting of SRC held on 12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup> February 2020 has considered the matter and decided to issue a Final Show Cause again. Accordingly, a Final Show Cause was issued to the institution on 27.02.2020. The institution has submitted reply on 11.03.2020.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 386<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 23<sup>rd</sup> & 24<sup>th</sup> July, 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue a last reminder letter. Accordingly, a last reminder letter was issued to the institution on 17.08.2020. The institution has submitted reply received on 14.09.2020.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 393<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on 05<sup>th</sup> – 06<sup>th</sup> January, 2021 considered the matter and decided to issue withdraw the recognition. Accordingly, a withdrawal order was issued to the institution on 22.01.2021.

8. **AND WHEREAS**, aggrieved by the order of the SRC, the institution preferred an appeal u/s 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 and the Appellate Authority vide order No. F.No.89-39/E-176014/2021 Appeal/9 Mtg.-2021/25<sup>th</sup> February, 2021/98309 dated 26.03.2021 remanded back the matter to SRC. The institution vide letter dated 01.03.2021 submitted reply to the appeal remand back case.

9. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 399<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup> June 2021 has considered the matter and the Committee decided to issue a last reminder letter. Accordingly, a last reminder letter was issued to the institution on 06.07.2021. The institution vide letter dated 07.07.2021 has submitted a reply in response to the last reminder letter.



**10. AND WHEREAS,** the matter was placed before the SRC in its 400<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup> July 2021 and the Committee decided as follows: -

*"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-*

*The Committee on perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution Blessy College of Education, Survey No. 26/3, 26/4, 27/3, 39/2, 32/3, Navalingam Nagar, Chidambaram Taluk, Cuddalore District-608001, Tamilnadu for B.Ed. programme for 2 basic units of 50 students each".*

**11. NOW THEREFORE,** this order is issued permitting the institution i.e. Blessy College of Education, Survey No. 26/3, 26/4, 27/3, 39/2, 32/3, Navalingam Nagar, Chidambaram Taluk, Cuddalore District-608001, Tamilnadu run Alan Education Trust, Cuddalore District-608001, Tamilnadu for Continuation of recognition for B.Ed. programme for two year duration 2 basic units of 50 students each subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

**12.** Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.

**13.** The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

**14.** The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
- b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter:
- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;




- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
  - e. Fee charged from students;
  - f. Available infrastructural facilities;
  - g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
  - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
  - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
  - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information if it so desires.
  - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
15. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
16. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
17. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.
