WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

WHEREAS, permission u/s15 (1) of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, Bharath Institute of Teacher Training Institute, RS No.236/1B, Thiruvennkadam Nagar Road, Nilgiri Therkku Thottain, Thanjavur-613001, TamilNadu run by K.Nadumuthu Memorial Educational Trust, Thanjavur District-613001, TamilNadu vide SRC (NCTE) order no.F.SRO/NCTE/D.T.Ed./2006-2007/8036 dated 19.02.2008 for conducting Elementary D.T.Ed. Course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students.

2. AND WHEREAS, a letter dated 07.08.2020 has been received from the institution regarding closure of the admission for D.El.Ed.

3. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 412th meeting held on 05th – 06th July 2022 took note about non-functioning of the website of the institutions which is mandatory requirement as per NCTE Regulations, 2014. In view of the non-compliance, the Regional Committee advised the Regional Director, SRC to issue Show Cause Notice to all such institution seeking infrastructure and structural details along with GIS Location at the earliest. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 07.09.2022.

4. AND WHEREAS, a letter has been received from the institution on 20.09.2022 regarding closure of the institution.

5. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 414th Meeting of SRC held on 26th – 27th September 2022 considered the matter requesting for closure and decided as under: -

"The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Committee noted that the institution has not filled Performance Appraisal Report (PAR)

The Committee agreed to close down the institution as requested by the Institution vide letter dated 20.09.2022 by withdrawing the recognition granted to Bharath Institute of Teacher Training Institute, RS No.236/1B, Thiruvennkadam Nagar Road, Nilgiri Therkku Thottain, Thanjavur-613001, TamilNadu for conducting D.T.Ed Programme under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic session 2022-2023.

However, the FDRs towards Reserve Fund and Endowment Fund/ No Objection Certificate (NOC) for encashment of FDRs will be issued by the Regional Director as per the general resolution taken by the SRC in its earlier meeting".

6. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby agreed to close down the institution by withdrawing recognition granted to **Bharath Institute of Teacher Training Institute, RS No.236/1B, Thiruvennkadam Nagar Road, Nilgiri Therkku Thottain, Thanjavur-613001, TamilNadu** run by **K.Nadumuthu Memorial Educational Trust, Thanjavur District-613001, TamilNadu** for conducting **D.T.Ed. Course** of two years duration with an annual intake of **50 students (one unit)** with effect from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023 onwards.

7. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education or immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained in pursuance to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

8. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
