**CONTINUATION ORDER**

WHEREAS, recognition u/s 14 Act of NCTE, 1993 was granted to the institution namely **Peet Memorial Training College, Mavelikara, Kerala - 690101** vide order no. F.KL/Sec/14/SRO/NCTE/1999-2000/5231 on 22.03.2000 to conduct B.Ed. Secondary course of one year duration.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit on 28.01.2015 for its willingness of two units in B.Ed. course and adherence of provisions of new Regulations. Thereafter, a Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 26.05.2015 for conducting **B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 150 (three basic units of 50 students) from the academic session 2015-16.**

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order was placed before the SRC in its 369<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 13.03.2019. The institution has submitted its reply on 16.04.2019 & 06.05.2019.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 383<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on 07<sup>th</sup> to 09<sup>th</sup> January, 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 22.01.2020. The institution has submitted its reply on 24.02.2020.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 408<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 02<sup>nd</sup> March, 2022 considered the matter and decided to withdraw the recognition. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a withdrawal order No. F.SRO/NCTE/AOSO0399/B.Ed./KL/2022/130846-130850 dated 14.03.2022 was issued to the institution for B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 150 students (3 basic units).

6. **AND WHEREAS**, aggrieved by the withdrawal order, the institution preferred an appeal to NCTE-Hqrs. The Appellate Authority in its order No. 89-110/E-251079/2022 Appeal/5<sup>th</sup> Mtg.2022 dated 12.07.2022 the Council confirms the Orders appealed/against.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has filed Writ Petition before Hon'ble High Court of Kerala at Ernakulam bearing W.P(C) No. 24026/2022 vide order dated 29.07.2022 titled as Peet Memorial Training College Versus National Council for Teacher Education & Anr. As per direction of Hon'ble High Court the Petitioner College has submitted representation along with documents on dated which were received in the office on 17.08.2022.

8. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 413<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> - 23<sup>rd</sup> August, 2022 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly,

as per the decision of SRC Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 05.09.2022. The institution has submitted reply on 09.09.2022.

9. **AND WHEREAS**, vide order dt. 29.07.2022 passed by the Hon'ble High Court wherein the institution has admitted that the institution has confined/chosen to have only one unit intake i.e., 50 students for B.Ed. programme & 25 students for M.Ed. programme. Now, the institution has submitted faculty for one unit i.e., 50 students only.

10. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 414<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2022 considered the matter and decided as follows: -

*"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -*

*The Committee on the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution Peet Memorial Training College, Ward No. 5, Survey No.17/6, Mavelikara Municipality, Mavelikara, Alappuzha District, Kerala-690101 for B.Ed. programme for 1 basic unit of 50 students."*

11. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e., Peet Memorial Training College, Ward No. 5, Survey No.17/6, Mavelikara Municipality, Mavelikara, Alappuzha District, Kerala-690101 run by CSI Diocese and Church Mission Society, Ward No. 5, Survey No.17/6, Mavelikara Municipality, Mavelikara, Alappuzha District, Kerala-690101 for Continuation of recognition for B.Ed. programme for two years duration with an annual intake of 1 basic unit of 50 students subject to fulfilment of the following conditions: -

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

12. Further, the institution is required to fulfil all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.

13. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

14. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the



programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely: -

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
- b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter:
- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
- e. Fee charged from students.
- f. Available infrastructural facilities.
- g. Facilities added during the last quarter.
- h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
- i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information if it so desires.
- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

15. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.


16. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.

17. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.
