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PREAMBLE:

National Teacher Training Institute, Kuttikonam, Kunnicode P.O. Pin - 691508, Kollam District, Kerala has made application for grant of recognition for **Elementary** course of two years duration to Southern Regional Committee on 12.12.2003.

On scrutiny of the application it was found that application was incomplete and essential documents as required under regulations were not submitted.

Accordingly, an offer letter with deficiencies was issued to the above institution for elementary course by SRC on 04.03.2004 stating the following deficiencies :-

- ❖ Certificate of registration, Memorandum of Association and Bye laws.
- ❖ Legally valid land documents to be in the name of Society.
- ❖ Copy of approved building plan should be approved by Municipal Corporation / Panchayath.

In reply to the above letter, institution in its letter dated.29.11.2003 has submitted following documents :

- ❖ Certificate of registration, Memorandum of Association and Bye laws.
- ❖ Legally valid land documents to be in the name of Society.
- ❖ Copy of approved building plan should be approved by Municipal Corporation / Panchayath.

The institution was visited on 26.03.2004 to assess the infrastructural and instructional facilities. The visiting team report was placed before 77th meeting of SRC held on 29th and 30th July 2004 and decided to issue notice before rejecting the proposal for elementary course. Accordingly, Notice was served on 17.08.2004 by pointing out the following deficiencies:

- ❖ The rooms meant for classes, labs, staff, etc are not adequate as per NCTE norms.
- ❖ The books in the library are inadequate.
- ❖ Science, Psychology and Educational Technology laboratories are not equipped.
- ❖ Instructor for Physical Education, Work Experience and Art are not identified.

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The written representation of the institution dated 09.08.2004 was placed before 78th meeting of SRC held on 31st August 2004 and 1st September 2004 and SRC decided to reject the proposal as the institution had made compliance subsequent to the issue of notice. Rejection orders were served on 23.09.2004 with the following deficiencies.

- ❖ The rooms meant for classes, labs, staff, etc are not adequate as per NCTE norms.
- ❖ The books in the library are inadequate.
- ❖ Science, Psychology and Educational Technology laboratories are not equipped.
- ❖ Instructor for Physical Education, Work Experience and Art are not identified.

The applicant institution preferred appeal before NCTE, New Delhi against the rejection order issued by this office dated 23.09.2004. The Appellate Authority considered the appeal and passed order on 19th November 2005 directing the SRC-NCTE to reprocess the case by causing an early inspection of the institution.

Accordingly, an inspection team was deputed to the institution on 11th February 2005. The report of the inspection team was placed before the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE in its 90th meeting held on 17th and 18th March, 2005.

Considering the report of the inspection team, the Regional Committee decided to issue notice to the institution for not fulfilling the norms and standards as stipulated under regulation of NCTE for the said course on 30.03.2005 with the following deficiencies.

- ❖ The accommodation for reading room in the library is not sufficient.
- ❖ Books on teacher education, methodology subjects are not adequate.
- ❖ Protected drinking water facilities are not available.

The written representation of the institution dated 06.04.2005 was placed before 91st meeting of SRC held on 11-12 April 2005 and SRC decided to re-visit the institution to verify the claims made by them. Accordingly, visit was sent on 08.05.2005 and the same was placed before 94th meeting of SRC held on 24th June 2005. SRC considered the visiting team report and decided to accord recognition.

Hence the following order

ORDER

In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **National Teacher Training Institute, Kuttikonam, Kunnicoode P.O. Pin – 691508, Kollam District, Kerala** had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting **Elementary course of two year duration** from the academic session **2004-2005** with an annual intake of **50 students**.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

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- a) The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education Institution.
- b) The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land.
- c) The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs.5.00 Lakhs and a Reserve Fund of Rs.1,05,232/-.
- d) The institution has selected the Principal / Head and **five** teachers for the said course and the staff list is approved by SCERT, Thiruvananthapuram.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **National Teacher Training Institute, Kuttikonam, Kunnicode P.O. Pin – 691508, Kollam District, Kerala** for **Elementary course of two year duration** from the academic session **2005-2006** with an annual intake of **50** students subject to fulfillment of the following.


- a) The institution will ensure that **six** exclusive faculty members (Principal/Head and five teachers) are in position for an intake of **50** students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Committee immediately and in any case before commencement of the course.
- b) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
- c) The institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition (in case the course is started in temporary premises).
- d) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC / University / State Government etc.,

5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University for the appointment of faculty members and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

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6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
