ORDER

WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Infant Jesus Chritable And Educational Trust, Trichy District, Tamilnadu** has submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition to **Infant Jesus Teacher Training Institute, K. Kallikudi, Ramjeenagar Post, Trichy-620 009, Tamilnadu** for **Elementary(D.T.Ed)** course of two years duration with an annual intake of **50 (Fifty)** Students:

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, the Committee is satisfied that the institution fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the said teacher education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratories etc for running the programme and has appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Infant Jesus Teacher Training Institute, K. Kallikudi, Ramjeenagar Post, Trichy-620 009, Tamilnadu** for conducting **Elementary(D.T.Ed)** course of two years duration with an annual intake of **50(Fifty)** students under clause 7(12) of Regulations dated.13.01.2006. This order of recognition shall be prospective and take effect from the date of issue of this order, subject to fulfillment of the following:

- i) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Southern Regional Committee.
- ii) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- iii) The institution will ensure that **Principal and Five** faculty members duly approved by DTER, Chennai are in position for an intake of **50** students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately.

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University / bodies, State Government etc, as applicable.
5. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body.
6. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
7. The institution shall maintain & update the Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations.
8. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

The SRC considered the matter of according of Unconditional recognition to the institutions which have submitted replies to the Conditional Recognition letter issued.

The SRC also considered the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Madras in the batch judgement pronounced on 25.04.2007 and several orders thereon pertaining to the issuance of Unconditional Recognition orders to the institutions. The text of the judgement of the operative portion is as under :

"All the petitioners shall submit affidavit by the management regarding the appointment of staff in Rs.100/- stamp paper in the prescribed format, affidavit in Rs.10/- from the individual staff members in the prescribed format and staff profile if the same have not already been submitted within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and on receipt of such request from the writ petitioners, the same shall be considered by NCTE and pass appropriate order thereon within a period of two weeks there from and grant unconditional recognition without insisting for the approval by the concerned affiliating body like University, SCERT, DTER, DSERT etc.,"

The SRC also took note that several institutions have submitted individual directions from the Hon'ble High Court of Tamilnadu in the similar manner pertaining to their institutions.

SRC after a detailed deliberations on the issue and also that the some of the Universities and State Governments are not considering the issuance of staff approval, in order to maintain the uniformity in all the states under the jurisdiction or SRC, the SRC resolved to implement the directions of Hon'ble High Court of Tamilnadu to all institutions which have been issued with Conditional Recognition letter and to issue Unconditional Recognition order subject to submission of affidavit by the management regarding the appointment of staff in Rs.100/- stamp paper in the prescribed format, affidavit in Rs.10/- from the individual staff members in the prescribed format and staff profile of the faculty appointed if the institutions has appointed staff with requisite qualification as prescribed by NCTE in the norms and standards for the particular course.

Further, the SRC resolved to incorporate Para 8(10) of NCTE Regulations dated.13.01.2006 AS IT IS in the unconditional recognition order to be issued to the institutions which states as under :

"An institution shall make admission only after it obtains unconditional letter of recognition from the Regional Committee concerned, and affiliation from the examining body"

SRC decided to seek concurrence from the NCTE, New Delhi regarding incorporation of new condition in the Unconditional recognition order.

Sri.K.Rayar, Member, SRC has expressed his descent over the incorporation of the new condition in the Unconditional Recognition order.

Further, SRC decided to authorise the Regional Director to implement the above decision and report the progress of issuance of UCR to the Regional Committee in subsequent meetings.
