WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the appellate authority vide order No.F.No.42-138/2001Appeal/20216 dated 19.04.2002 reversed the Order appealed against and granted recognition to **St. Jude's College of Education for Women, Vikarabad, Ranga Reddy, Andhra Pradesh** with an annual intake of B.Ed. course of 100 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dated 19.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 31.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in 381st meeting held on 31st Oct & 1st Nov, 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted requisite documents/VT Reports accompanied with requisite documents in respond to RPRO issued by the SRC. Accordingly, First Show Cause was issued on 25.11.2019. The institution vide letter dated 11.01.2020 submitted reply to the First Show Cause Notice.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 384th meeting held on 12th to 13th February 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 11.03.2020. The institution vide letter dated 20.03.2020 submitted its reply to the Final Show Cause Notice.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the mater was further considered by the SRC in its meeting 388th held on 14th – 15th September 2020 and the committee decided to issue Last Reminder Letter. Accordingly a Last Reminder Letter was issued to the institution on 24.09.2020 the institution has submitted Last Reminder Letter reply on 22.10.2020.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 410th Meeting held on 25th & 26th April 2022 considered the matter and decided as under:-

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The institution was issued a Last Reminder Letter. The institution has submitted its reply vide letter dated 22.10.2020. The Committee observed the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies.

1. *The institution has submitted photocopy of Land Document. The institution has not submitted certified copy of Land Document.*

2. The institution has submitted photocopy of Land Use Certificate dated 03.07.2009 issued by Assistant Engineer in which survey No. and Land Area are not mentioned.
3. The institution has submitted photocopy of Building Plan in which Survey no., site area and multipurpose hall area is not mentioned in the building plan. Also, the building plan does not show the name of the institution or society on which the institution wants to run the course.
4. The institution has submitted copy of Building Completion Certificate but not approved by Competent Authority.
5. The institution has submitted faculty approval letter date 02.06.2020 issued by Registrar Osmania University.
 - (i) The institution has submitted faculty in prescribed format but not approved by Competent Authority.
 - (ii) Sl No. 5, 6, 7 & 8 Assistant Professor does not have NET/Ph.D. as per NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) (Amendment) Regulations, 2017 dated 29.05.2017 notified on 09.06.2017, hence, not eligible to be appointed.
 - (iii) The institution has not appointed Faculty Physical Education and Fine Arts/Performing Arts
6. The website of the institution is not uploaded with the information required under clauses 7(14)(i), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
7. The institution did not submit proof of disbursement of salary to faculty & non-teaching staff through bank account as required under clause 10(2) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
8. The institution did not submit registration certificate and bye laws of the managing society / trust.

Hence the recognition granted to **St. Jude's College of Education for Women, Vikarabad, Ranga Reddy District- 501101, Telangana** for **B.Ed. course** is withdrawn under Section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 from the next academic session i.e. **2022-2023**. On withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body from the next academic session stands withdrawn. Hence, the institution is not entitled to participate in counselling / making admissions from the next academic session i.e. **2022-2023**."

7. **NOW, THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of **St. Jude's College of Education for Women, Vikarabad, Ranga Reddy District- 501101, Telangana** for conducting **B.Ed.** programme of two year duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units 50 each) for B.Ed. Programme with effect from the academic session i.e. 2022-2023 onwards. further on withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body from the academic session stands withdrawn. Hence, the institution is not entitled to participate in counseling / making admissions from the academic session i.e. **2022-2023**.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or

where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
