ORDER

WHEREAS, Chinmaya Vishwadyapeeth (Deemed to be University), Adi Sankara Nilayam, Adi Sankara Marg, Veiliyanad, Ernakulam District-682313, Kerala applied for grant of recognition to Chinmaya Vishwadyapeeth (Deemed to be University), Adi Sankara Nilayam, Adi Sankara Marg, Veiliyanad, Ernakulam District-682313, Kerala for offering B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. Integrated Course (Innovative programme) for four years duration for the academic year 2020-2021 under Section 14/15 of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE through online on 06.02.2019.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, as per the procedure, the application was forwarded to the Standing Committee on Integrated Course at the NCTE, New Delhi vide letter dated 08.02.2019. The NCTE Hqrs. Vide letter no. NCTE-Acad025/1/2019-Acad-HQ/75414 dt. 28.02.2019 approved the course content of the proposal of B.A. B.Ed. and B.Sc. B.Ed. 4 Years Integrated Programmes.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered by the SRC in its 373<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> March 2019 wherein the Committee decided to write a letter to Chinmaya Vishwadyapeeth to comply with the suggestions made by the Standing Committee. Thereafter, in compliance of the aforementioned decision, a letter dt. 28.03.2019 was issued to the University. In response, the Registrar (I/c) of the University vide letter dt. 29.03.2019 submitted a compliance report

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 374<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 09<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> April 2019 and the Committee decided to issue letter Deputy Secretary (Inspection). Accordingly, vide letter dt.12.04.2019 the Deputy Secretary (Inspection), NCTE was requested to constitute the VT Team. As per the direction of SRC, the inspection was conducted on 23.07.2019 and 24.07.2019 and the VT Report received in the office of SRC on 29.07.2019.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution was placed before the SRC in its 379<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 21<sup>st</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2019 and the Committee decided to issue reminder letter. Thereafter, as per the direction of the Committee, a reminder letter was issued to the institution vide order No.F.SRC/NCTE//Integrated Courses/2019/109062-109063 dt. 02.09.2019. The institution vide letters dt. 27.08.2019, 09.07.2019 & 06.09.2019 has submitted its reply Institution has enclosed the following documents along with its reply dt. 09.07.2019 and dt. 27.08.2019.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 380<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 18<sup>th</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup> September, 2019 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The original files of the institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act,1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were under:-

Therefore, the Committee decided to issue Letter of intent (LOI) under clause 7(13) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014. The institution be asked to submit staff list/FDR etc as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, as per the decision of SRC a LOI was issued to the institution on dt: 26.09.2019. Thereafter, the institution submitted reply to the LOI vide letter dated 22.11.2019.

8. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered by SRC in its 383<sup>rd</sup> Meeting held on January 7-9, 2020 and decided the following: -

The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Committee noted that the Institution was issued Letter of Intent (LOI) under clause 7(13) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 and the institution submitted its reply on 22.11. 2019. The Committee perused the staff list submitted by the Institution and decided to grant recognition to the institution under clause 7(16) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 subject to **appointment of faculty (3 Asst. Professor in Perspective in Education which include a person with Philosophy/Psychology/Sociology/Technology) background in addition to the faculty list submitted by the Institution** as detailed below:-

- (i) B.Sc. B.Ed. (Mathematics) – 1 Unit (50 students)
- (ii) B.A.B.Ed. (English) – 1 Unit (50 students)

9. **AND WHEREAS**, as per the decision of SRC a letter was issued to the institution on 20.01.2020. In response, the institution vide letter dated 17.01.2020 has informed that they have initiated the process of recruiting the faculty as per decision of SRC. In continuation, the institution submitted reply dated 02.03.2020 received on 05.03.2020.

10. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 387<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 24<sup>th</sup> – 25<sup>th</sup> August, 2020 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The Original file of the institution along with original documents and records submitted by the institution, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued from

time to time were carefully considered by SRC. It has been observed that the inspection report of Chinmaya Vishwavidyapeeth (Deemed to be University), Ernakulam, Kerala and other documents were considered by SRC and Letter of Intent was issued on 26.09.2019. Further, the institution has submitted reply to LOI on 21.10.2019 and 22.11.2019. The SRC in its 383<sup>rd</sup> Meeting held during 7 – 9 January, 2020 has considered the said replies and decided to grant recognition to the institution with conditions for the following courses :

- (i) B.Sc. B.Ed (Mathematics) – 1 Unit (50 Students)
- (ii) B.A. B.Ed (English) – 1 Unit (50 Students)

The decision of according Recognition to the above institution was taken by SRC well within the time stipulation of 3<sup>rd</sup> March as directed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

The institution has submitted the compliance report dated 02.03.2020 (received on 5.3.2020) for the conditions laid down pursuant to the decision of according Recognition. Due to Covid – 19 situations arise throughout the country, the meeting of SRC could not be conducted till July. Accordingly, the reply submitted by the institution was considered by SRC in its 386<sup>th</sup> meeting held during 23-24 July, 2020. After detailed consideration of the matter, the SRC decided to reiterate the decision already taken in the 383<sup>rd</sup> Meeting held during 7 – 9 January, 2020 to grant recognition to the courses detailed above.

It is again reiterated that the recognition to Chinmaya Vishwavidyapeeth (Deemed to be University), Ernakulam, Kerala is granted in accordance with the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court and decision of grant of recognition taken in the 383<sup>rd</sup> meeting held during 7 – 9 January, 2020 shall be implemented and accordingly recognition order be issued for the session 2020-2021.

**11. NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act 1993, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to **Chinmaya Vishwadyapeeth (Deemed to be University), Adi Sankara Nilayam, Adi Sankara Marg, Veiliyanad, Ernakulam District-682313, Kerala** for conducting B.Sc. B.Ed (Mathematics) – 1 Unit (50 Students) and B.A. B.Ed (English) – 1 Unit (50 Students) **Integrated Course (Innovative programme)** for four year duration from the academic sessions 2020-2021 under Clause 7(16) of NCTE (Regulation Norms & Procedure) Regulation, 2014 subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- (a) **The institution shall adhere to the fulfillment of the provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014, as amended from time to time, and ensure the following before commencement of the session:-**
  - (i) The institution shall comply with various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, as amended from time to time.
  - (ii) The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of Clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
  - (iii) The institution shall comply with condition laid down in clause 8(3) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014, as amended vide Notification on 29.04.2017, which provides as under:-

- **An institution, which has been recognised by the Council shall obtain accreditation from an accrediting agency identified by the Council within five years of the date of recognition.**
- **All existing Teacher Education Institutions which have not been accredited so far or have not been accredited within five years from the date of its recognition shall be required to get themselves accredited by the aforesaid accrediting agency within a period of one year from the date of notification of these Regulations.**
- **The accreditation once obtained shall be valid for a period of five years and the recognised and already accredited Teacher Education Institutions shall be required to get accreditation renewed by the agency identified for the purpose by the Council before the lapse of the earlier accreditation.**

- (iv) The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
- (v) The Norms for teaching staff in respect of their qualifications and experience shall be as per provisions of NCTE Regulations, 2014, as amended from time to time.

12. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, State Government etc. as applicable, and compliance of the following by the affiliating body, State Govt. and also the concerned recognized Institution:-

- (i) **The affiliating body shall be required to verify the authenticity of the land & building documents submitted by the institution, with the required land & built up area as well as appointment of requisite teaching & non-teaching staff as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 before grant of affiliating to the institution.**
- (ii) **The affiliating body shall ensure that the norms including the norms of Faculty for offering Integrated 4 year component of the programme as per curriculum of these programme in the University, is scrupulously observed as per recommendation of the Standing Committee of the NCTE.**

13. The institution shall submit a Self-Appraisal Report to the Regional Committee at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

14. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display as mandatory disclosure the following:-

- (i) Copy of Application Form
- (ii) Land and Building Particulars
- (iii) Staff Profile
- (iv) Recognition Order
- (v) Information regarding fulfilment of norms & standards and other conditions for the course.

15. In case, if the land is in the name of the Society/Trust, the land is to be transferred within six months from the date of recognition order in the name of the institution, failing

which action shall be initiated for withdrawal of recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate about the same to the Regional Committee along with new land documents within the stipulated time.


16. The Educational Institution shall follow Uniform Accounting System as brought out by ICAI and accepted by the MHRD.

17. The Institution shall fill the GIS Application within one month from the date of issue of this order.

18. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules and Regulations, the Regional Committee shall withdraw recognition under provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

19. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website [www.ncte-india.org](http://www.ncte-india.org) within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.


