WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

WHEREAS, recognition u/s 14 Act of NCTE, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, **B.R.V. B.Ed. College, # 8 & 9, Mahadeshwara Nagar Extension, Vishwaneedam Post, Bangalore, Karnataka-560091** run by **Sagar Education Trust, Bangalore, Karnataka** vide SRC order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2005-2006/4813 dt. 16.01.2006 for conducting Secondary (B.Ed.) course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (Hundred) students from the academic session 2005-06.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit on 30.01.2015 for its willingness of two units in B.Ed. course and adherence of provisions of new Regulations. Thereafter, a Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 24.06.2016 for conducting **B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.**

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 388th Meeting held on 14th & 15th September, 2020 the matter was considered and decided to issue Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 24.12.2020. The institution did not submit any reply to Show Cause Notice.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 405th Meeting held on 13th & 14th December, 2021 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on dt. 29.12.2021. The institution did not submit any reply to Final Show Cause Notice.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 413th Meeting held on 22nd & 23rd August, 2022 considered the matter and decided as under: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made were made: -

- (i) *The institution failed to submit reply to the Final Show Cause Notice dated 29.12.2021.*

*Hence the recognition granted to **B.R.V. B.Ed. College, # 8 and 9, Mahadeshwara Nagar Extension, Vishwaneedam Post, Bangalore, Karnataka-560091** for **B.Ed. course** is withdrawn under Section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 from the end of next academic session i.e., **2023-2024**. On withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body from the next academic session stands withdrawn."*

6. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby agreed to close down the institution by withdrawing recognition granted to **B.R.V. B.Ed. College, # 8 and 9, Mahadeshwara Nagar Extension, Vishwaneedam Post, Bangalore, Karnataka-560091** run by **Sagar Education Trust, Bangalore, Karnataka** for conducting **B.Ed. programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **100 students (2 basic unit)** with effect from the end of next academic session i.e., 2023-2024.

7. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

8. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
