WHEREAS, recognition u/s14 Act of NCTE, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, Sagar Gangotri Education Institution, J.C. Road, Sagar, Shimoga District, Karnataka-577401 vide SRC (NCTE) order No. F.SRO/NCTE/APS07308/B.Ed./2007-2008/13062 dated 11.05.2007 for conducting (B.Ed.) Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

- 2. AND WHEREAS, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution had consented to come under new Regulations vide a notarized affidavit dated 03.02.2015 and the provisional revised recognition order was issued on 18.05.2015 to the institution for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.
- 3. AND WHEREAS, the status of issuance of SCN/FSCN was considered by the Sub-Committee constituted by the SRC in its meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> Oct, 2019. The Sub-Committee noted that institutions have not submitted requisite documents or only part reply has been submitted. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC First Show Cause Notice was issued on 24.10.2019. The institution has submitted its reply on 13.11.2019.
- **4. AND WHEREAS,** the SRC in its 388<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup>& 15<sup>th</sup> September, 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC Final Show Cause Notice to the institution on 21.09.2020. The institution has submitted its reply on 17.11.2020.
- **5. AND WHEREAS,** the SRC in its 392<sup>nd</sup> Meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup> December, 2020 considered the matter and decided to withdraw the recognition. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC a withdrawal order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APSO3683/B.Ed./KA/392<sup>nd</sup>/2020/21169-1175 dated 18.12.2020 was issued to the institution.
- **6. AND WHEREAS,** the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order No. 89-195/E-190620/2021 Appeal/19<sup>th</sup> Meeting, 2021 Appeal No.APPLSRC202113905 dated 10.09.2021 appeal remand back the order appealed against. The institution has submitted reply of appeal remand back case on 28.07.2021 along with the document
- 7. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 403<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on 18<sup>th</sup>& 19<sup>th</sup> October 2021 has considered the matter and the Committee decided to issue a continuation order. Accordingly, a Continuation order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APSO3683/B.Ed./KA/2021/128912 dated 27.10.2021 was issued to the institution.

- **8. AND WHEREAS,** Vide letter dated 30.12.2021 a complaint dt. 22.10.2021 filed by Sh. Rajesab Mallapur S/o Basusab, 65, Asundi, Ranebennur Tq, haveri District, Karnataka regarding violation of rules and regulations of NCTE by submitting false and fakes documents enclosed with a letter and documents was received.
- **9. AND WHEREAS,** the SRC in its 407<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup> February 2022 has considered the matter and decided to constitute the Visiting Team to verify the infrastructure & instructional facilities. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a letter was issued to the institution on 28.02.2022. The institution vide letter dated 19.03.2022 has submitted a written representation along with report and observations regarding inspection in response to the letter.
- **10. AND WHEREAS,** the SRC in its 411<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 23<sup>rd</sup>& 24<sup>th</sup> May, 2022 considered the matter and decided to issue a notice/letter to the institution. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC a letter was issued to the institution on 03.06.2022. The institution has submitted a written representation on 20.06.2022, 22.06.2022.
- 11. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 412<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 05<sup>th</sup>& 06<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 considered the matter and decided as under:-

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:

The institution failed to submit reply to the Notice dated 03.06.2022 and also keeping in view the report submitted by the Sub-committee of the SRC on their visit to the institution decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Sagar Gangotri Education Institution, J.C. Road, Sagar, Shimoga District, Karnataka-577401 for B.Ed. course is withdrawn under Section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 from the end of next academic session i.e., 2023-2024. On withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body from the next academic session stands withdrawn. Hence, the institution is not entitled to participate in counselling / making admissions from the next academic session i.e., 2023-2024.

The Committee further deliberated on the false allegations made by the Management of Sagar Gangotri Education Institution, J.C. Road, Sagar, Shimoga District, Karnataka-577401. In the light of the report submitted by the Sub-Committee of the SRC, the Committee advise the Regional Director to lodge a FIR against the Management for maligning the image of the Sr. Members of the SRC.

Further, the RD is also advised to write to the Secretary, Higher Education, Govt. of Karnataka, Chairman, Bar Council of India and Nursing Council of India, New Delhi about the present status of the institution as reported by the Sub-Committee of the SRC.

12. NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to Sagar Gangotri Education Institution, J.C. Road, Sagar, Shimoga District, Karnataka-577401 for conducting B.Ed. Programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (Two basic units) with effect from the academic session i.e., 2023-2024 onwards.

Further, on withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body from the academic session stands withdrawn. Hence, the institution is not entitled to participate for counseling from the academic session i.e., 2023-2024 and the institution is also not permitted to take any fresh admission of students from the academic session 2023-2024.

**13.** Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

**14.** Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website <a href="www.ncte-india.org">www.ncte-india.org</a> within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
